

SENATE BILL NO. 558—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

APRIL 17, 2007

Referred to Committee on Finance

SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to northern and southern Nevada music therapy programs for the purchase of various equipment. (BDR S-1469)

AN ACT making appropriations to northern and southern Nevada music therapy programs for the purchase of various equipment; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to:

1. The Center for Creative Therapeutic Arts, Las Vegas, the sum of \$58,815 for the purchase of instruments, equipment, music, supplies and software for music therapy services.

2. Esther Bennett Elementary School, Sun Valley, the sum of \$6,705 for the purchase of instruments, equipment, music, supplies and software for music therapy services.

3. Marvin Picollo School, Reno, the sum of \$15,325 for the purchase of instruments, equipment, music, supplies and software for music therapy services.

4. The Note-Ables, Reno, the sum of \$28,745 for the purchase of instruments, equipment, music, supplies and software for music therapy services.

Sec. 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by section 1 of this act, the Center for Creative Therapeutic Arts and The Note-Ables, respectively, shall:

1 1. Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
2 Committee on or before December 15, 2008, that describes each
3 expenditure made from the money appropriated by section 1 of this
4 act from the date on which the money was received by the Center
5 for Creative Therapeutic Arts and The Note-Ables, respectively,
6 through December 1, 2008;

7 2. Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance
8 Committee on or before September 18, 2009, that describes each
9 expenditure made from the money appropriated by section 1 of this
10 act from the date on which the money was received by the Center
11 for Creative Therapeutic Arts and The Note-Ables, respectively,
12 through June 30, 2009; and

13 3. Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
14 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,
15 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or
16 otherwise, of the Center for Creative Therapeutic Arts and The
17 Note-Ables, respectively, regardless of their form or location, that
18 the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct an audit of the
19 use of the money appropriated pursuant to section 1 of this act.

20 **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by
21 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
22 June 30, 2009, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or
23 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
24 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
25 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
26 after September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money
27 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
28 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
29 Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

30 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
