

## SENATE BILL NO. 562—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

APRIL 30, 2007

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Referred to Committee on Finance

**SUMMARY**—Transfers money from the Fund for the Promotion of Tourism to the Western Folklife Center for the National Cowboy Poetry Gathering and to the Atomic Testing Museum. (BDR S-1451)

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets **[omitted material]** is material to be omitted.

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AN ACT relating to tourism; transferring money from the Fund for the Promotion of Tourism to the Western Folklife Center for the National Cowboy Poetry Gathering; transferring money from the Fund for the Promotion of Tourism to the Atomic Testing Museum; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** 1. The Commission on Tourism shall, as soon as  
2 practicable after July 1, 2007, and July 1, 2008, respectively,  
3 without depleting the funds necessary for day-to-day operations,  
4 transfer the following amounts from the proceeds from the taxes  
5 imposed on the revenue from the rental of transient lodging which  
6 have been credited to the Fund for the Promotion of Tourism,  
7 created by NRS 231.250, to the Western Folklife Center for support  
8 of the National Cowboy Poetry Gathering in Elko, Nevada:

9              For the Fiscal Year 2007-2008.....\$100,000  
10             For the Fiscal Year 2008-2009.....\$100,000

11        2. Upon acceptance of the money transferred pursuant to  
12 subsection 1, the Western Folklife Center shall:

13            (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance  
14 Committee on or before December 15, 2008, that describes each

1 expenditure made from the money transferred pursuant to  
2 subsection 1 from the date on which the money was received by the  
3 Western Folklife Center through December 1, 2008;

4 (b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance  
5 Committee on or before September 18, 2009, that describes each  
6 expenditure made from the money transferred pursuant to  
7 subsection 1 from the date on which the money was received by the  
8 Western Folklife Center through June 30, 2009; and

9 (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available  
10 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,  
11 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or  
12 otherwise, of the Western Folklife Center, regardless of their  
13 form or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to  
14 conduct an audit of the use of the money transferred pursuant to  
15 subsection 1.

16 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the transfer made by section  
17 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30 of  
18 the respective fiscal years by the entity to which the money is  
19 transferred or any entity to which the money from the transfer is  
20 granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of  
21 the transferred money remaining must not be spent for any purpose  
22 after September 19, 2008, and September 18, 2009, respectively, by  
23 either the entity to which the money was transferred or the entity to  
24 which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must  
25 be reverted to the Fund for the Promotion of Tourism on or before  
26 September 19, 2008, and September 18, 2009, respectively.

27 **Sec. 3.** 1. The Commission on Tourism shall, as soon as  
28 practicable after July 1, 2007, and July 1, 2008, respectively,  
29 without depleting the funds necessary for day-to-day operations,  
30 transfer the following amounts from the proceeds from the taxes  
31 imposed on the revenue from the rental of transient lodging which  
32 have been credited to the Fund for the Promotion of Tourism,  
33 created by NRS 231.250, to the Atomic Testing Museum in Las  
34 Vegas for an educational program at the Museum:

35 For the Fiscal Year 2007-2008.....\$100,000  
36 For the Fiscal Year 2008-2009.....\$100,000

37 2. The money transferred pursuant to subsection 1 must be  
38 used by the Museum to:

39 (a) Provide instructional materials in classrooms;  
40 (b) Allow access to the Internet for teachers and pupils; and  
41 (c) Subsidize admission and transportation costs for schools and  
42 waive entirely admission for pupils who attend designated at-risk  
43 schools.

44 3. Upon acceptance of the money transferred pursuant to  
45 subsection 1, the Museum shall:



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1       (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance  
2 Committee on or before December 15, 2008, that describes each  
3 expenditure made from the money transferred pursuant to  
4 subsection 1 from the date on which the money was received by the  
5 Museum through December 1, 2008;

6       (b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance  
7 Committee on or before September 18, 2009, that describes each  
8 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1  
9 from the date on which the money was received by the Museum  
10 through June 30, 2009; and

11      (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available  
12 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,  
13 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or  
14 otherwise, of the Museum, regardless of their form or location, that  
15 the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct an audit of the  
16 use of the money transferred pursuant to subsection 1.

17      4. Any balance of the sums transferred pursuant to subsection 1  
18 remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not be  
19 committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal  
20 years by the entity to which the transfer is made or any entity to  
21 which money from the transfer is granted or otherwise provided in  
22 any manner, and any portion of the money remaining must not be  
23 spent for any purpose after September 18, 2009, by either the entity  
24 to which the money was transferred or the entity to which the  
25 money was subsequently granted or provided, and must be  
26 reverted to the Fund for the Promotion of Tourism on or before  
27 September 19, 2008, and September 18, 2009, respectively.

28      **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
