**SUMMARY**—Revises the provisions relating to misconduct in the signing or filing of petitions. (BDR 15-770)

AN ACT relating to petitions; revising the provisions relating to misconduct in the signing or filing of petitions; providing penalties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Under existing law, a person is guilty of a misdemeanor if the person: (1) signs the name of another person or of a fictitious person on a petition; (2) files a petition or causes a petition to be filed knowing that the petition contains a false or wrongful signature or statement; (3) signs his name to or withdraws his name from a petition for any consideration, gratuity or reward; or (4) subscribes to any false statement concerning his age, citizenship, residence or other qualification. (NRS 205.125) This bill increases the penalty, from a misdemeanor to a category D felony, if a person: (1) signs the name of another person or of a fictitious person on a petition; or (2) files a petition or causes a petition to be filed knowing that the petition contains a false or wrongful signature or statement. This bill also prohibits a person from adding to, revising or altering a petition with the intent to falsify the name or any information concerning the age, citizenship or residence of another person who signs the petition. A person who commits one of these new crimes is guilty of a category D felony.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** NRS 205.125 is hereby amended to read as follows:

another person or of a fictitious person to or for any consideration,~~

1 gratuity or reward shall sign his own name to or withdraw his name  
2 from any]

3     1. A person shall not willfully sign the name of another  
4 person, whether living or deceased, or of a fictitious person to any  
5 petition. A person who violates the provisions of this subsection is  
6 guilty of a category D felony and shall be punished as provided in  
7 NRS 193.130. Each false or wrongful signature on a petition in  
8 violation of this subsection, whether related to a single petition or  
9 multiple petitions, constitutes a separate offense.

10     2. A person shall not willfully add to, revise or alter any  
11 petition with the intent to falsify the name or any information  
12 concerning the age, citizenship or residence of another person  
13 who signs the petition. A person who violates the provisions of this  
14 subsection is guilty of a category D felony and shall be punished  
15 as provided in NRS 193.130. Each addition, revision or alteration  
16 to a petition in violation of this subsection, whether related to a  
17 single petition or multiple petitions, constitutes a separate offense.

18     3. A person shall not willfully offer or provide any  
19 consideration, gratuity or reward to another person with the intent  
20 to induce the other person to sign his own name to or withdraw his  
21 own name from any petition. A person who violates the provisions  
22 of this subsection is guilty of a category D felony and shall be  
23 punished as provided in NRS 193.130. Each offer or provision of  
24 consideration, gratuity or reward to another person in violation of  
25 this subsection, whether related to a single petition or multiple  
26 petitions, constitutes a separate offense.

27     4. A person shall not, knowing that any petition contains any  
28 false or wrongful signature, statement or information, file the  
29 petition or cause the petition to be filed. A person who violates the  
30 provisions of this subsection is guilty of a category D felony and  
31 shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130. Each filing of a  
32 petition in violation of this subsection, whether related to a single  
33 petition or multiple petitions, constitutes a separate offense.

34     5. A person shall not, in signing his own name to any  
35 petition, willfully subscribe to any false statement concerning his  
36 age, citizenship, residence or other qualifications to sign the  
37 petition. A person who violates the provisions of this subsection is  
38 guilty of a misdemeanor. Each subscription to a false statement in  
39 violation of this subsection, whether related to a single petition or  
40 multiple petitions, constitutes a separate offense.

41     6. As used in this section, "petition" means a referendum or  
42 other petition circulated in pursuance of any law of this State or any  
43 municipal ordinance. { or in signing his name to such petition shall  
44 willfully subscribe to any false statement concerning his age,  
45 citizenship, residence or other qualifications to sign the same; or

1 knowing that any such petition contains any such false or wrongful  
2 signature or statement shall file the same, or put the same off with  
3 intent that it should be filed, as a true and genuine petition, shall be  
4 guilty of a misdemeanor.]
