SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Recognizing February 6, 2007, as Ronald Reagan Day.

- 1 WHEREAS, President Ronald Wilson Reagan, a man of humble  
2 background, worked throughout his life to preserve freedom and  
3 advance the public good, having been employed as an entertainer, a  
4 union leader and a corporate spokesman and having served as  
5 Governor of California and President of the United States; and  
6 WHEREAS, Ronald Reagan performed the duties of our nation’s  
7 highest office with honor and distinction for two terms as the 40th  
8 President of the United States; and



1 WHEREAS, In 1981, when Ronald Reagan was first inaugurated  
2 as President, he inherited a disillusioned nation shackled by rampant  
3 inflation and high unemployment; and

4 WHEREAS, The election results that initiated Ronald Reagan's  
5 second term as President demonstrated he had earned the confidence  
6 of three-fifths of the electorate and awarded him the victory in 49 of  
7 the 50 states, a record that is unsurpassed in the history of American  
8 presidential elections; and

9 WHEREAS, During Ronald Reagan's presidency, he worked in a  
10 bipartisan manner to enact his bold agenda of restoring  
11 accountability and common sense to government, which led to  
12 unprecedented economic expansion and opportunity for millions of  
13 Americans; and

14 WHEREAS, President Reagan's commitment to our Armed  
15 Forces contributed to the restoration of pride in America, her values  
16 and the ideals cherished by the free world, and prepared America's  
17 Armed Forces to meet the challenges of the 21st century; and

18 WHEREAS, President Reagan's vision of "peace through  
19 strength" led to the end of the Cold War and the ultimate demise of  
20 the Soviet Union, guaranteeing basic human rights for millions of  
21 people; and

22 WHEREAS, Throughout his presidency, Ronald Reagan  
23 displayed consistent optimism and the self-confidence that endeared  
24 him to millions, and even when personal danger threatened him, as  
25 in the assassination attempt in 1981, he remained upbeat and  
26 reassuring; and

27 WHEREAS, February 6, 2007, will be the 96th anniversary of  
28 Ronald Reagan's birth and the third since his passing; now,  
29 therefore, be it

30 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE  
31 ASSEMBLY CONCURRING, That the members of the Nevada  
32 Legislature do hereby declare February 6, 2007, to be Ronald  
33 Reagan Day in Nevada in honor of the man who dedicated his life to  
34 the service of our country and is recognized as one of the most  
35 influential presidents of our great nation; and be it further

36 RESOLVED, That all residents of this State are urged to take  
37 cognizance of this event and participate fittingly in its observance;  
38 and be it further

39 RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate prepare and  
40 transmit a copy of this resolution to Nancy Reagan, Ronald  
41 Reagan's loving and devoted wife of 52 years.
