

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 18—COMMITTEE  
ON HUMAN RESOURCES AND EDUCATION

(ON BEHALF OF THE LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE  
ON PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES)

**SUMMARY**—Expresses support for vocational rehabilitation programs and services in this State. (BDR R-296)

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SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Expressing support for vocational rehabilitation programs and services in this State.

1        WHEREAS, Vocational rehabilitation programs and services are  
2 of great importance to persons with disabilities in this State, helping  
3 such individuals so that they may prepare for and engage in gainful  
4 employment and live more independently; and

5        WHEREAS, The Department of Employment, Training and  
6 Rehabilitation has access to state and federal money to cover the  
7 costs of providing vocational rehabilitation services to persons with  
8 disabilities; and

9        WHEREAS, The costs of providing such services can include,  
10 without limitation, costs for assessment, counseling, medical and  
11 psychological services, vocational and other training, job placement,  
12 transportation, assistance to persons who are blind and deaf, and  
13 other goods and services needed by persons with disabilities; and

14       WHEREAS, This money can also be used to assist families of  
15 persons with disabilities who are being provided vocational  
16 rehabilitation services and to benefit groups of such persons by the  
17 construction and establishment of community programs; and

18       WHEREAS, The Rehabilitation Services Administration of the  
19 United States Department of Education, which allocates Section 110  
20 funding based on disability population demographics, allocated



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1 \$3,000,000 to the Rehabilitation Division that was not matched for  
2 Fiscal Year 2006, causing the loss of this money; and

3 WHEREAS, Preliminary estimates indicate that for the next fiscal  
4 year, Nevada will continue to send back federal money that could  
5 fund beneficial programs for which the need is critical; now,  
6 therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE  
8 ASSEMBLY CONCURRING, That the members of the Nevada  
9 Legislature hereby express their support for the use of state and  
10 federal money for the development of facilities, programs and other  
11 resources needed by persons with disabilities in this State to help  
12 them prepare for and engage in gainful employment; and be it  
13 further

14 RESOLVED, That the Department of Employment, Training and  
15 Rehabilitation is encouraged to continue to seek private  
16 contributions to make up the difference between current State  
17 General Fund expenditures and the total matching money needed to  
18 allow the Department to use the full allotment of federal money; and  
19 be it further

20 RESOLVED, That by using private and state money to provide a  
21 full match, and thereby maximizing the receipt of federal money,  
22 the Department will be able to provide vocational rehabilitation  
23 services to help persons with disabilities consistent with their  
24 strengths, resources, priorities, concerns, capabilities, interests and  
25 informed choice; and be it further

26 RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate prepare and  
27 transmit a copy of this resolution to the Director of the Department  
28 of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation.
