

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 8—COMMITTEE ON
HUMAN RESOURCES AND EDUCATION

MARCH 5, 2007

Referred to Committee on Legislative Operations and Elections

SUMMARY—Directs the Legislative Commission to conduct an interim study of the use of methamphetamine in this State. (BDR R-1177)

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Directing the Legislative Commission to conduct an interim study of the use of methamphetamine in this State.

1 WHEREAS, The State of Nevada leads the nation in the number
2 of people who use methamphetamine; and

3 WHEREAS, The effects of the use of methamphetamine present a
4 serious risk to the health, safety and welfare of the residents of this
5 State; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE
7 ASSEMBLY CONCURRING, That the Legislative Commission is
8 hereby directed to appoint a committee, composed of three members
9 of the Assembly and three members of the Senate to conduct an
10 interim study of the use of methamphetamine in this State; and be it
11 further

12 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Commission shall designate a
13 Chairman of the committee and shall appoint an advisory committee
14 of eight nonvoting members, who are not Legislators, as follows:

- 15 1. One representative of the Office of the Attorney General;
- 16 2. One representative of the district attorneys of this State;
- 17 3. One representative of the law enforcement agencies of this
18 State;
- 19 4. One representative of the Division of Parole and Probation
20 of the Department of Public Safety;
- 21 5. One district judge who is assigned to the drug court;
- 22 6. One district judge who is assigned to the juvenile court;



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1 7. One representative of the child protection agencies of this
2 State; and

3 8. One representative of the school districts of this State; and
4 be it further

5 RESOLVED, That the study must include, without limitation, an
6 examination of:

7 1. Information concerning the nature and extent of the use of
8 methamphetamine in this State, the importation and manufacture
9 of methamphetamine in this State and the most effective methods of
10 decreasing the supply of methamphetamine in this State;

11 2. The effects of the use of methamphetamine on the health,
12 safety and welfare of the residents of this State;

13 3. The most effective methods for the prevention and treatment
14 of the abuse of methamphetamine; and

15 4. Projections for the future needs for services for the
16 prevention and treatment of the abuse of methamphetamine in this
17 State; and be it further

18 RESOLVED, That any recommended legislation proposed by the
19 committee must be approved by a majority of the members of the
20 Senate and a majority of the members of the Assembly appointed to
21 the committee; and be it further

22 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Commission shall submit a
23 report of the results of the study and any recommendations for
24 legislation to the 75th Session of the Nevada Legislature.

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
