SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION—Urging Congress to support a proposed off-highway vehicle park in Clark County.

1        WHEREAS, The Nellis Dunes area comprises approximately  
2 10,181 acres located in unincorporated Clark County, Nevada, on  
3 federal public lands managed by the Bureau of Land Management,  
4 8,921 acres of which are usable recreation space, offering a variety  
5 of terrain and trails for off-highway vehicle enthusiasts; and

6        WHEREAS, Most areas of Clark County have been closed to  
7 motorized recreation, and the Las Vegas Valley is in a state of  
8 noncompliance for air quality with regard to particulate matter,  
9 partially due to blowing dust from land disturbance caused by off-  
10 road vehicle use; and

11      WHEREAS, The Nellis Dunes is recognized in the Southern  
12 Nevada Regional Planning Coalition's open space plan to protect  
13 the natural backdrops and maintain a perimeter trail corridor around  
14 the Las Vegas Valley; and

15      WHEREAS, The Bureau of Land Management's Las Vegas  
16 Resource Management Plan designates the Nellis Dunes as an "open  
17 area," allowing unrestricted motorized recreation; and

18      WHEREAS, An opportunity exists for Clark County to develop  
19 and manage a motorized recreation system, consistent with the  
20 mission of Nellis Air Force Base, with the potential to prevent  
21 safety concerns, improve air quality, protect rare plants and sensitive

1    soils, prevent refuse dumping and capitalize on potential economic  
2    development possibilities; and

3    WHEREAS, A feasibility study, funded by the Board of County  
4    Commissioners for Clark County, evaluated supply and demand  
5    considerations, capital and operations and maintenance costs and  
6    options for funding, and likely operation models for a motorized  
7    recreation park; and

8    WHEREAS, Development of a motorized recreation park  
9    managed by Clark County will benefit southern Nevadans through  
10   the promotion of safe off-road activities and implementation of  
11   environmental protections to air, sensitive soils and native plants;  
12   now, therefore, be it

13   RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF  
14   NEVADA, JOINTLY, That the members of the Nevada Legislature  
15   hereby urge Congress to promulgate legislation for the conveyance  
16   of the Nellis Dunes area to Clark County for the purpose of off-road  
17   recreation and environmental protection; and be it further

18   RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate prepare and  
19   transmit a copy of this resolution to the Vice President of the United  
20   States as the presiding officer of the United States Senate, the  
21   Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Board of County  
22   Commissioners of Clark County and each member of the Nevada  
23   Congressional Delegation; and be it further

24   RESOLVED, That this resolution becomes effective upon  
25   passage.
