BDR 19-774—Revises provisions concerning the protection of certain personal identifying information. (Later introduced as [Assembly Bill 600](#).)

BDR 25-139—Creates the Account for Workforce Housing to provide money for certain affordable housing projects; providing that money from the

Account for Low-Income Housing may be used to assemble and acquire property for the development of affordable housing. (Later introduced as [Assembly Bill 603](#).)

BDR 23-1148—Increases the number of members of the Employee-Management Committee; requiring that certain persons in the classified service of the State be granted a leave of absence without pay to serve as full-time representatives in organizations representing state employees. (Later introduced as [Assembly Bill 602](#).)

BDR 23-1147—Authorizes collective bargaining for certain state employees; provides for bargaining units and their representatives; establishes procedures for collective bargaining; and prohibits certain labor practices. (Later introduced as [Assembly Bill 601](#).)
