[Roll call] We have four Bill Draft Requests to introduce.

- **BDR 19-774**—Revises provisions concerning the protection of certain personal identifying information. (Later introduced as <u>Assembly Bill 600</u>.)
- **BDR 25-139**—Creates the Account for Workforce Housing to provide money for certain affordable housing projects; providing that money from the

Account for Low-Income Housing may be used to assemble and acquire property for the development of affordable housing. (Later introduced as Assembly Bill 603.)

- BDR 23-1148—Increases the number of members of the Employee-Management Committee; requiring that certain persons in the classified service of the State be granted a leave of absence without pay to serve as full-time representatives in organizations representing state employees. (Later introduced as Assembly Bill 602.)
- BDR 23-1147—Authorizes collective bargaining for certain state employees; provides for bargaining units and their representatives; establishes procedures for collective bargaining; and prohibits certain labor practices. (Later introduced as Assembly Bill 601.)
