Bill Draft Request S-1424 was a request made by the Governor's office for the dignitary protection detail, explained Vice Chair Leslie.

• BDR S-1424 – Makes a supplemental appropriation to the Department of Public Safety, Dignitary Protection, for unanticipated shortfalls in Fiscal Year 2006-2007 for dignitary protection. (Assembly Bill 616)

• BDR S-1449 – Makes an appropriation to Build Nevada for career and technical programs. (Assembly Bill 614)

ASSEMBLYWOMAN WEBER SECONDED THE MOTION.

The last bill draft request was an appropriation for domestic violence prevention programs, indicated Vice Chair Leslie.

• BDR S-1450 – Makes an appropriation to the Family Development Foundation for domestic violence prevention programs. (Assembly Bill 613)
