Vice Chairman Sheila Leslie informed the Committee members that she had several bill drafts which required Committee introductions. The first bill draft was for an appropriation to the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency, BDR S-1222.

- **BDR S-1222 – Makes a contingent appropriation to the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency for replacement of vehicles. (Assembly Bill 618)**

ASSEMBLYMAN GRADY SECONDED THE MOTION.

Vice Chair Leslie indicated the next bill draft was an appropriation to the Rainy Day Fund.

- **BDR S-1228 – Makes an appropriation to the Fund to Stabilize the Operation of the State Government. (Assembly Bill 617)**

ASSEMBLYMAN DENIS SECONDED THE MOTION.

THE MOTION PASSED. (CHAIR ARBERRY WAS ABSENT FOR THE VOTE.)

Bill Draft Request S-1424 was a request made by the Governor's office for the dignitary protection detail, explained Vice Chair Leslie.

- **BDR S-1424 – Makes a supplemental appropriation to the Department of Public Safety, Dignitary Protection, for unanticipated shortfalls in Fiscal Year 2006-2007 for dignitary protection. (Assembly Bill 616)**

ASSEMBLYWOMAN GANSERT MOVED FOR COMMITTEE INTRODUCTION OF BDR S-1424.

ASSEMBLYWOMAN McCLAIN SECONDED THE MOTION.

THE MOTION PASSED. (CHAIR ARBERRY WAS ABSENT FOR THE VOTE.)

Vice Chairman Leslie said the next bill draft referred to local financial administration, and Mrs. Smith added that it would address rural school districts and general obligation bonds.

- **BDR 30-1474 – Makes various changes concerning local financial administration. (Assembly Bill 615)**

ASSEMBLYMAN HOGAN SECONDED THE MOTION.

THE MOTION PASSED. (CHAIR ARBERRY WAS ABSENT FOR THE VOTE.)

Bill Draft Request S-1449 related to Build Nevada, advised the Vice Chair.

- **BDR S-1449 – Makes an appropriation to Build Nevada for career and technical programs. (Assembly Bill 614)**

ASSEMBLYMAN HARDY MOVED FOR COMMITTEE INTRODUCTION OF BDR S-1449.

ASSEMBLYWOMAN WEBER SECONDED THE MOTION.

THE MOTION PASSED. (CHAIR ARBERRY WAS ABSENT FOR THE VOTE.)

The last bill draft request was an appropriation for domestic violence prevention programs, indicated Vice Chair Leslie.

- **BDR S-1450 – Makes an appropriation to the Family Development Foundation for domestic violence prevention programs. (Assembly Bill 613)**
