BILL DRAFT REQUEST 54-295: Makes various changes concerning the practice of interpreting and the practice of realtime captioning. (Later introduced as [Senate Bill 473.](#))

BILL DRAFT REQUEST 54-600: Limits the liability of a public agency that pays for the services of a personal assistant for a person with a disability. (Later introduced as [Senate Bill 474.](#))

BILL DRAFT REQUEST 57-1133: Revises certain provisions governing policies of insurance for motor vehicles. (Later introduced as [Senate Bill 475.](#))

BILL DRAFT REQUEST 54-1389: Makes various changes concerning business practices. (Later introduced as [Senate Bill 476](#).)

BILL DRAFT REQUEST 10-1327: Makes various changes relating to the licensing and regulation of time-share sales agents. (Later introduced as [Senate Bill 477](#).)

BILL DRAFT REQUEST 32-1392: Makes various changes regarding the appeal of property assessments made for purposes of taxation. (Later introduced as [Senate Bill 478](#).)
