- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 20-225: Revises provisions governing the compensation of certain elected county officers. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 516.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 31-229</u>: Provides a declaration of legislative intent regarding the use of certain lease-purchase and installment-purchase agreements. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 515.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 31-230: Requires the approval of certain changes in the scope of installment-purchase and lease-purchase agreements. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 520.

- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 31-274: Authorizes the Nevada System of Higher Education to carry forward and use unexpended appropriations for need-based scholarships and financial aid for students. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 521.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 28-379: Authorizes certain additional public bodies to negotiate with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder to obtain a revised bid on a contract for a public work in certain circumstances. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 507.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 35-401: Establishes Monte Cristo State Park in Esmeralda County, Nevada. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 514.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 18-403: Creates the position of Coordinator of Geographic Information Systems for Natural Resources within the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 513.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 31-424: Makes various changes to provisions relating to state financial administration and the acquisition of property. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 509.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 22-443</u>: Revises provisions governing the approval of certain plans, designs and specifications for school buildings. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 499.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 21-488: Authorizes incorporated cities to enter into lease-purchase agreements for the construction or remodeling of buildings or facilities. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 512.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 31-495: Makes various changes relating to state financial administration. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 511.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 10-496</u>: Makes various changes relating to abandoned property. (Later introduced as <u>Senate Bill 519</u>.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 19-575</u>: Creates the Office of Information Security within the Department of Information Technology. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 508.)

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- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 31-627</u>: Revises provisions governing work programs. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 518.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 31-633: Requires that certain payments to the State of Nevada be made electronically. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 517.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST S-964</u>: Revises the authority of the Virgin Valley Water District to borrow money and incur indebtedness. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 498.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 22-1352: Revises provisions relating to certain public facilities. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 497.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 23-1367</u>: Authorizes contracts between legal services organizations and local governmental agencies for the provision of insurance. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 500.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 19-1435: Makes various changes to provisions governing the State Board of Pardons Commissioners and the State Board of Parole Commissioners. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 496.)
