- BILL DRAFT REQUEST S-1360: Increases the rate of Medicaid reimbursements for hospitals. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 524.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST S-309: Makes an appropriation to the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy of the Department of Health and Human Services for services to Medicaid recipients with traumatic brain injuries. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 523.)

- BILL DRAFT REQUEST S-768: Makes appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services for the State Dental Health Officer and various wellness programs. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 527.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 40-744</u>: Creates the Task Force for a Methamphetamine Free Nevada and makes various appropriations relating to public health. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 530.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 40-1388</u>: Makes various changes relating to county hospitals. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 533.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST S-769: Makes appropriations to the Nevada System of Higher Education and The Orvis Nursing Clinic of the University of Nevada, Reno, for the expansion of nursing programs and health care services. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 526.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST S-433</u>: Makes appropriations for various programs relating to students who are deaf or hard of hearing. (Later introduced as <u>Senate Bill 525</u>.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST R-296</u>: Expresses support for vocational rehabilitation programs and services in this State. (Later introduced as <u>Senate Concurrent Resolution 18.</u>)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 32-1179</u>: Provides for an incremental reduction in certain excise taxes payable by financial institutions and other employees that contribute to health savings accounts for their employees. (Later introduced as <u>Senate Bill 528</u>.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 39-298</u>: requires the Division of Mental Health and Developmental Services of the Department of Health and Human Services to provide copies of serious incident reports involving clients to certain agencies. (Later introduced as <u>Senate Bill 531</u>.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 38-1359</u>: Makes various changes relating to public welfare. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 532.)

<u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST S-311</u>: Makes appropriations for the provision of various health care services. (Later introduced as <u>Senate Bill 522</u>.)
