S.B. 100 (R1) Requires an insurer or third-party administrator who pays workers' compensation to an employee or a dependent of an employee to deposit the compensation directly into the account of the employee or dependent under certain circumstances. (BDR 53-465)

S.B. 281 (R1) Revises provisions governing industrial insurance. (BDR 53-1136)

S.B. 474 Limits the liability of a public agency that pays for the services of a personal assistant for a person with a disability. (BDR 54-600)
