S.B. 6 (R1)      Includes marijuana in the provision which prohibits persons from intentionally allowing children to be present at certain locations where certain crimes involving controlled substances are committed. (BDR 40-223)

S.B. 7 (R1)      Establishes civil liability for certain acts involving the use of controlled substances and the consumption of alcoholic beverages. (BDR 3-53)

S.B. 132      Makes various changes concerning the liability of trailbuilding organizations and landowners, lessees and occupants of land to persons using premises for recreational activities. (BDR 3-212)

S.B. 202 (R1)      Makes various changes relating to domestic relations. (BDR 11-215)
