Work session scheduled on any previously heard measures which may include the following:

<u>A.B. 8</u>	Prohibits a person from being admitted to bail for at least 12 hours after his arrest for driving a vehicle or operating a vessel under the influence of intoxicating liquor or a controlled substance. (BDR 14-704)
<u>A.B. 77</u>	Makes various changes concerning the competency of defendants. (BDR 14-801)
A.B. 83	Revises provisions governing criminal and civil liability for crimes motivated by the actual or perceived status of the victim as a homeless person. (BDR 15-533)
<u>A.B. 100</u>	Eliminates the requirement that a certified court reporter be appointed as a notary public to administer oaths and affirmations. (BDR 54-572)
<u>A.B. 117</u>	Revises provisions relating to the exclusion of certain persons from divorce proceedings. (BDR 11-217)
<u>A.J.R. 3</u>	Proposes to amend the Nevada Constitution to revise provisions relating to the taking of private property by eminent domain. (BDR C-529)
