<u>A.B. 24</u> (R1)	Revises provisions governing the release of a consumer report by a credit reporting agency. (BDR 52-518)
A.B. 34	Revises provisions governing unemployment compensation. (BDR 53-610)
<u>A.B. 215</u> (R1)	Limits interstate banking by certain entities that open branch offices in this State pursuant to certain statutory provisions. (BDR 55-1125)
A.B. 224 (R1)	Makes various changes to provisions governing the regulation of factory-built housing, manufactured buildings and modular components. (BDR 43-583)
A.B. 286	Exempts certain health insurers from provisions governing the denial of claims and the cancellation of or refusal to issue a policy or contract of health insurance. (BDR 57-990)
<u>A.B. 303</u> (R1)	Adds provisions relating to insurers who require medical examinations before issuing, renewing, reinstating or reevaluating policies of insurance.
