FIRST REVISED AGENDA

S.B. 54 Revises provisions governing industrial insurance to create a presumption of intoxication or use of a controlled substance under certain circumstances. (BDR 53-803)

S.B. 100 Requires an insurer or third-party administrator who pays workers' compensation to an employee or a dependent of an employee to deposit the compensation directly into the account of the employee or dependent under certain circumstances. (BDR 53-465)
