- [S.B. 108](#) Provides for the use of zero-based budgeting in the state budget process. (BDR 31-476)
- [S.B. 166](#) Requires payment of increased salaries to certain school employees holding national certification. (BDR 34-1149)
- [S.B. 167](#) Makes an appropriation to the Department of Education to support apprenticeship programs certified by the State Apprenticeship Council. (BDR S-1005)
- [S.B. 183](#) Revises provisions governing administrative positions in the Public Employees' Retirement System. (BDR 23-281)
