<u>S.B. 45</u>	Provides for the imposition of an administrative assessment on a person convicted of driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or a controlled substance. (BDR 14-672)
<u>S.B. 88</u>	Adopts the Uniform Real Property Electronic Recording Act. (BDR 10-461)
<u>S.B. 89</u>	Makes various changes concerning legal representation of state agencies, officers and employees. (BDR 3-1)

S.B. 10	Prohibits certain acts relating to capturing or distributing an image of the private area of another person under certain circumstances. (BDR 15-5)
S.B. 57	Requires the parent of a child who is the victim of a sexual offense to give written consent before the name of the child may be included in a notice provided to a school. (BDR 5-669)
