WORK SESSION

- [S.B. 14](#) Provides that a minor who possesses tobacco products or falsely represents his age to obtain tobacco products is subject to the jurisdiction of the juvenile court as a child in need of supervision. (BDR 5-76)
- [S.B. 30](#) Revises the provisions governing the early release of prisoners from county or city jails to relieve overcrowding. (BDR 16-362)
- [S.B. 33](#) Requires the manager of a gated community to provide to parole and probation officers the code or device which allows entry to the community. (BDR 16-560)
- [S.B. 35](#) Revises certain provisions relating to the admissibility of certain affidavits and declarations in certain proceedings. (BDR 4-507)
- [S.B. 36](#) Authorizes the board of county commissioners to include longevity pay in the compensation of justices of the peace. (BDR 1-269)
- [S.B. 37](#) Makes various changes to provisions governing the testimony and evidence of a witness who is granted immunity in a criminal proceeding. (BDR 14-278)
- [S.B. 66](#) Increases the amount of damages that may be awarded in certain tort actions brought against a governmental entity or its officers or employees. (BDR 3-120)
- [S.B. 70](#) Enacts the Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds Act. (BDR 13-970)
- [S.B. 72](#) Adopts the Uniform Limited Partnership Act (2001) and provides for its applicability on a voluntary basis. (BDR 7-720)
