A.B. 143 (R1) Revises provisions relating to the Commission on Ethics. (BDR 23-855)

A.J.R. 1 (R1) Proposes to amend the Nevada Constitution to provide for forfeiture of public office for three or more violations of ethical duties. (BDR C-171)
