- [S.J.R. 11](#)      Encourages certain activities relating to the use of biomass in the production of energy in Nevada. (BDR R-402)
- [S.J.R. 12](#)      Expresses disapproval of recent civil actions filed against local ranchers and the Bureau of Land Management in the management of public rangelands and the issuance of grazing permits for those public rangelands. (BDR R-396)
- [S.J.R. 13](#)      Urges Congress to provide additional appropriations for the prevention and suppression of wildfires and the rehabilitation of public rangelands in Nevada. (BDR R-468)
