(BDR 43-425) Requires a vehicle dealer to notify the buyer of a vehicle service contract A.B. 239 if the provider of the vehicle service contract ceases doing business in this State. (BDR 43-971) A.B. 489 (R1) Revises provisions governing the towing of motor vehicles from public or private property. (BDR 43-345) Requires applicants for a special license plate to pay an application fee A.B. 54 (R1) which is refundable in certain circumstances. (BDR 43-740) A.B. 600 (R1) Revises provisions concerning the protection of certain personal identifying information. (BDR 19-774)
