AN ACT relating to watercraft; prohibiting the owner of a boat livery or his agent or employee from renting an aquatic device to any person unless the owner, agent or employee complies with certain requirements; increasing the age under which a person on a vessel is required to wear a personal flotation device; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

~~[[This]]~~ Section 1 of this bill prohibits the owner of a boat livery or his agent or employee from renting an aquatic device to any person unless the owner or his agent or employee complies with certain requirements, including, without limitation, providing to each person who will use the aquatic device a personal flotation device approved by the United States Coast Guard and giving verbal instructions for the safe use of the aquatic device. An "aquatic device" includes an inner tube or inflatable raft, but does not include a vessel or motorboat or any device used in a designated swimming area. Section 1 also prohibits a person who is less than 13 years of age from using an aquatic device unless the person is wearing a personal flotation device.

Section 2 of this bill changes the age under which a person on the topside of a noncommercial vessel is required to wear a personal flotation device from 12 years of age to 13.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1        **Section 1.** Chapter 488 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new  
2 section to read as follows:

3        1. The owner of a boat livery or his agent or employee shall not rent an  
4 aquatic device to any person unless the owner or his agent or employee:

5        (a) Provides to each person to whom the aquatic device is rented and to each  
6 person who will use the aquatic device;

7        (1) A personal flotation device of a type approved by the United States  
8 Coast Guard and prescribed by regulations adopted by the Commission;

9        (2) A written summary of the laws and regulations of this State  
10 governing the use of the aquatic device; and

11        (3) Verbal instructions regarding the safe use of the aquatic device; and

12        (b) Before the aquatic device leaves the control of the owner or his agent or  
13 employee, documents the name and age of each person who will use the aquatic  
14 device. The person to whom the aquatic device is rented shall ensure that only a  
15 person who is documented as a user is allowed to use the aquatic device.

16        2. Each person to whom an aquatic device is rented and each person who  
17 uses the aquatic device shall, before using the aquatic device:

18        (a) Review the written summary of the laws and regulations provided to him  
19 pursuant to subsection 1; or

20        (b) Provide written proof to the owner or his agent or employee that the  
21 person has received previous instruction in the safe use of the aquatic device.

22        3. A person shall not use or authorize another person to use an aquatic  
23 device under his control on any waters of this State unless each user of the  
24 aquatic device who is less than 13 years of age is wearing a personal flotation  
25 device of the type prescribed pursuant to subsection 1.

26        4. As used in this section, "aquatic device" means:

27        (a) An inflatable inner tube;

28        (b) A small, flexible plastic or inflatable raft; or

29        (c) A single-chambered device that is inflated with air.

30        ↳ The term does not include a device which is classified as a vessel or motorboat  
31 or which is used in an area that is designated for swimming.

32        ~~Section 1.~~ **Sec. 2.** NRS 488.575 is hereby amended to read as follows:

33        488.575 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, a person shall not  
34 operate or authorize another person to operate a vessel under his ownership or  
35 control on any waters of this State unless each person on the vessel who is less than  
36 ~~12~~ 13 years of age is wearing a personal flotation device of a type approved by the  
37 United States Coast Guard and prescribed by the regulations of the Commission  
38 while the vessel is under way.

39        2. The provisions of subsection 1 do not apply to persons on board:

40        (a) A commercial vessel licensed by the United States Coast Guard for the  
41 transportation of passengers for hire; or

42        (b) Any other vessel who are below the deck or inside a cabin of the vessel.

43        **Sec. 3. 1. This section and section 1 of this act become effective upon**  
44 **passage and approval for the purpose of adopting regulations pursuant to**  
45 **section 1 of this act and on January 1, 2008, for all other purposes.**

46        2. Section 2 of this act becomes effective on October 1, 2007.
