AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Education for upgrading video equipment and replacing computer equipment; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
2 Department of Education the sum of ~~(\$129,000)~~ **\$127,579** for upgrading
3 videoconferencing equipment in the Carson City and Las Vegas offices, and
4 purchasing replacement computer hardware and software.

5 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this
6 act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2009, by the entity to
7 which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the
8 appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of
9 the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after
10 September 18, 2009, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or
11 the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be
12 reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 18, 2009.

13 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
