AN ACT relating to license plates; requiring the ~~Department of Motor Vehicles to issue special license plates authorized for use by veterans to be available for use on motorcycles.~~ **Commission on Special License Plates to study the feasibility of the design, preparation and issuance of certain special license plates for use on motorcycles;** and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

- 1 Existing law does not authorize special license plates to be made for use on motorcycles.
- 2 (NRS 482.272) ~~Five special license plates are authorized to be issued to specific categories of~~
- 3 ~~veterans of the United States Armed Forces for use on passenger cars and light commercial~~
- 4 ~~vehicles. (NRS 482.3763, 482.3765, 482.377, 482.3775, 482.378) This bill requires the~~

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Delete existing sections 1 through 6 of this bill and replace with the following  
2 new section 1:  
3

4 *Section 1. 1. The Commission on Special License Plates shall study the*  
5 *feasibility of the design, preparation and issuance of special license plates for*  
6 *use on motorcycles. The study must include, without limitation:*

7 (a) A determination of the feasibility of designing and preparing special  
8 license plates for use on motorcycles;

9 (b) A plan for the issuance of special license plates for use on motorcycles,  
10 including special license plates issued pursuant to NRS 482.3672 to 482.37945,  
11 inclusive; and

12 (c) The costs of implementing the plan described in paragraph (b).

13 2. On or before January 1, 2009, the Commission on Special License  
14 Plates shall submit a report of the results of the feasibility study conducted  
15 pursuant to subsection 1, including, without limitation, any recommendations  
16 for legislation, to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for  
17 transmission to the 75th Session of the Nevada Legislature.
