AN ACT relating to persons with disabilities; requiring the Director of ~~{the Department of Health and Human Services}~~ **a certain family resource center** to employ **an administrator to provide certain services to** two outreach coordinators ~~{to}~~ **who** provide ~~{education and}~~ information relating to the availability of services, programs, financial assistance and other resources for adults with disabilities; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 This bill requires the Director of the ~~{Department of Health and Human Services}~~ **Ron**  
2 **Wood Family Resource Center** to employ **an administrator to provide education,**  
3 **information and oversight to** a Northern Nevada Outreach Coordinator and a Southern  
4 Nevada Outreach Coordinator. ~~{to}~~ **The Outreach Coordinators** provide ~~{education and}~~  
5 information relating to services, programs, financial assistance and other resources that are  
6 available to adults with disabilities and their families from the Department ~~{}~~ **of Health and**  
7 **Human Services**, the Federal Government, local governments and private organizations. **This**  
8 **bill requires the Outreach Coordinators to be graduate students at the University of**  
9 **Nevada, Reno, and the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, who are engaged in a**  
10 **practicum or internship that is a requirement for their degrees.**

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Delete existing section 1 of this bill and replace with the following new sections  
2 1 and 2:

4 *Section 1. Chapter 430A of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a  
5 new section to read as follows:*

6 *1. The Director of the Ron Wood Family Resource Center shall employ a*  
7 *part-time administrator, not more than 30 hours per week, to provide education,*  
8 *information and oversight to a Northern Nevada Outreach Coordinator and a*  
9 *Southern Nevada Outreach Coordinator.*

10 *2. Each Outreach Coordinator shall, under the auspices of the Ron Wood*  
11 *Family Resource Center, provide information relating to the services, programs,*  
12 *financial assistance and other resources that are available to adults with*  
13 *disabilities and their families. The resources for which education and*  
14 *information must be provided include, without limitation, the resources available*  
15 *from the Department of Health and Human Services, the Federal Government,*  
16 *local governments and private organizations.*

17 *3. An Outreach Coordinator must be:*

18 *(a) A graduate student in a field of study approved by the Director of the Ron*  
19 *Wood Family Resource Center; and*

20 *(b) Engaged in a practicum or internship in fulfillment of a requirement for*  
21 *his graduate degree.*

22 *↳ The Northern Nevada Outreach Coordinator must be enrolled at the*  
23 *University of Nevada, Reno, and the Southern Nevada Outreach Coordinator*  
24 *must be enrolled at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas.*

25 *Sec. 2. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.*
