AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Department of Health and Human Services for expenses relating to foster care; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Department
2 of Health and Human Services for Clark County Integration the sum of ~~\$22,696,701~~
3 **\$3,320,695** for an unanticipated shortfall in purchased placement costs and for 14 full-time
4 equivalent positions needed for the increased foster care caseload. This appropriation is
5 supplemental to that made by section 20 of chapter 434, Statutes of Nevada 2005, at page
6 1940.

7 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
