AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Department of Health and Human Services for expenses relating to foster care; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services for Clark County Integration the sum of ~~(\$2,696,701)~~ **\$3,320,695** for an unanticipated shortfall in purchased placement costs and for 14 full-time equivalent positions needed for the increased foster care caseload. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 20 of chapter 434, Statutes of Nevada 2005, at page 1940.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
