AN ACT making supplemental appropriations to the Department of Motor Vehicles for various costs; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1       **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to  
 2 the Director’s Office of the Department of Motor Vehicles the sum of ~~[\$1,147,377]~~  
 3 **\$615,116** for an anticipated shortfall in operating costs for kiosks throughout the  
 4 State. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 32 of chapter 434,  
 5 Statutes of Nevada 2005, at page 1943.
- 6       2. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the  
 7 Department of Motor Vehicles, Automation Division, the sum of \$374,024 for  
 8 unanticipated Department of Information Technology charges. This appropriation is  
 9 supplemental to that made by section 32 of chapter 434, Statutes of Nevada 2005, at  
 10 page 1943.
- 11       3. ~~[There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the~~  
 12 ~~Department of Motor Vehicles for the Division of Central Services and Records the~~  
 13 ~~sum of \$665,656 to offset a revenue loss that resulted from the repeal of the sales~~  
 14 ~~tax on the occasional sale of motor vehicles. This appropriation is supplemental to~~  
 15 ~~that made by section 32 of chapter 434, Statutes of Nevada 2005, at page 1943.~~
- 16       ~~4. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the~~  
 17 ~~Department of Motor Vehicles for the Division of Compliance Enforcement the~~  
 18 ~~sum of \$19,940 for unbudgeted increases in fuel costs. This appropriation is~~  
 19 ~~supplemental to that made by section 32 of chapter 434, Statutes of Nevada 2005, at~~  
 20 ~~page 1943.~~
- 21       ~~5.]~~ There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the  
 22 Hearings Office of the Department of Motor Vehicles the sum of ~~[\$7,500]~~ **\$5,378**  
 23 for a shortfall in operating costs due to an increased hearing caseload. This

1 appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 32 of chapter 434, Statutes of  
2 Nevada 2005, at page 1943.
