AN ACT making an appropriation to the ~~Department of Corrections~~ State Public Works Board to [provide modular] design housing units ~~at institutions within the Department of Corrections~~; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the ~~Department of Corrections~~ State Public Works Board the sum of ~~\$30,121,031~~ \$826,597 to [provide] design four [modular] housing units to accommodate inmate population growth ~~at institutions within the Department of Corrections~~.

2 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, ~~2009~~, 2007, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September ~~18, 2009~~, 21, 2007, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before September ~~18, 2009~~, 21, 2007.

3 **Sec. 3.** **The State Public Works Board is authorized to use the Design-Build delivery method for this project.**

4 **Sec. 4.** The project enumerated in this act is exempt from the competitive bidding requirements of chapters 333 and 338 of NRS, the Green Building Standards adopted pursuant to NRS 701.217, the administrative

1 regulations concerning consultant selection procedures and the provisions of
2 NRS 338.1711 to 338.1727, inclusive, governing contracts involving design-
3 build teams.

4 Sec. 5. Except as otherwise specified in this act, the State Public Works
5 Board shall carry out the provisions of this act as provided in chapter 341 of
6 NRS. The Board shall ensure that qualified persons are employed to
7 accomplish the authorized work. Every contract pertaining to the work must
8 be approved by the Attorney General.

9 Sec. 6. All state agencies involved in the design and construction of the
10 projects enumerated in this act shall cooperate with the State Public Works
11 Board to expedite the completion of the project.
