SUMMARY—Imposes certain conditions before a special license plate may be ~~[created and issued if it is intended to generate financial support for an organization which is not a governmental entity]~~ **designed, prepared and issued.** (BDR 43-859)

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; imposing certain conditions **on certain organizations** before a special license plate may be ~~[created]~~ **designed, prepared** and issued ; ~~[if it is intended to generate financial support for an organization which is not a governmental entity]~~ and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law authorizes a person to request the Department of Motor Vehicles to design, prepare and issue a special license plate by submitting an application to the Department. (NRS 482.367002) This bill provides that a person may only submit an application for a special license plate that is intended to generate support for ~~for~~ a nonprofit charitable organization ~~which is not~~ or a governmental entity if the organization ~~is a nonprofit charitable organization and satisfies~~ or entity only uses the financial support generated by the special license plate for charitable purposes relating to public health, education or general welfare and certain ~~other~~ criteria ~~are~~ met.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. NRS 482.367002 is hereby amended to read as follows:

482.367002 1. A person may request that the Department design, prepare and issue a special license plate by submitting an application to the Department. **A person may submit an application for a special license plate that is intended to generate financial support for an organization [which is not a governmental entity] only if:**

1 (a) ~~The~~ For an organization which is not a governmental entity, the
2 organization is established as a nonprofit charitable organization which provides
3 services to the community relating to public health, education or general welfare;

4 (b) For an organization which is a governmental entity, the organization
5 only uses the financial support generated by the special license plate for
6 charitable purposes relating to public health, education or general welfare;

7 (c) The organization is registered with the Secretary of State, if
8 registration is required by law, and has filed any documents required to remain
9 registered with the Secretary of State;

10 (d) The name and purpose of the organization do not promote,
11 advertise or endorse any specific product, brand name or service that is offered
12 for sale; and profit;

13 (e) The organization is nondiscriminatory ~~, nondenominational and~~
14 ~~does not encourage or discourage any religious belief or activity~~; and

15 (f) The license plate will not promote a specific religion, faith or antireligious
16 belief.

17 2. An application submitted to the Department pursuant to subsection 1:
18 (a) Must be on a form prescribed and furnished by the Department;
19 (b) Must be accompanied by a petition containing the signatures of at least
20 1,000 persons who wish to obtain the special license plate;
21 (c) Must specify whether the special license plate being requested is intended
22 to generate financial support for a particular cause or charitable organization and, if
23 so, the name of the cause or charitable organization; ~~and~~

24 (d) ~~If the special license plate being requested is intended to generate
25 financial support for a charitable organization which is not a governmental
26 entity, must~~ Must include proof that the organization satisfies the requirements
27 set forth in subsection 1; and

28 (e) May be accompanied by suggestions for the design of and colors to be used
29 in the special license plate.

30 3. The Department may design and prepare a special license plate requested
31 pursuant to subsection 1 if:

32 (a) The Department determines that the application for that plate complies with
33 subsection 2; and

34 (b) The Commission on Special License Plates approves the application for
35 that plate pursuant to subsection 5 of NRS 482.367004.

36 4. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 482.367008, the Department may
37 issue a special license plate that:

38 (a) The Department has designed and prepared pursuant to this section;

39 (b) The Commission on Special License Plates has approved for issuance
40 pursuant to subsection 5 of NRS 482.367004; and

41 (c) Complies with the requirements of subsection 8 of NRS 482.270,

42 → for any passenger car or light commercial vehicle upon application by a person
43 who is entitled to license plates pursuant to NRS 482.265 and who otherwise
44 complies with the requirements for registration and licensing pursuant to this
45 chapter. A person may request that personalized prestige license plates issued
46 pursuant to NRS 482.3667 be combined with a special license plate issued pursuant
47 to this section if that person pays the fees for personalized prestige license plates in
48 addition to the fees for the special license plate.

49 5. If, during a registration year, the holder of license plates issued pursuant to
50 the provisions of this section disposes of the vehicle to which the plates are affixed,
51 the holder shall:

52 (a) Retain the plates and affix them to another vehicle that meets the
53 requirements of this section if the holder pays the fee for the transfer of the

1 registration and any registration fee or governmental services tax due pursuant to
2 NRS 482.399; or

3 (b) Within 30 days after removing the plates from the vehicle, return them to
4 the Department.

5 **Sec. 2. The provisions of this act do not apply to any special license plate**
6 **which was approved by the Commission on Special License Plates or**
7 **authorized by the Legislature before the effective date of this act.**
