THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Department of Taxation the sum of ~~{*\$710,575*}~~ ***\$208,573*** for outstanding Fiscal Year 2005-2006 information technology costs . ~~{and a projected budgetary shortfall for Fiscal Year 2006-2007.}~~ This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 9 of chapter 434, Statutes of Nevada 2005, at page 1937.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
