AN ACT relating to the ~~[City of North Las Vegas]~~ **Southern Nevada Enterprise Community**; requiring the ~~[City]~~ **Southern Nevada Enterprise Community Advisory Board** to develop a ~~[program]~~ project to make certain improvements to infrastructure in and near the ~~[Southern Nevada Enterprise]~~ Community; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

1 **Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

2 This bill enacts the ~~[North Las Vegas]~~ **Southern Nevada Enterprise Community**
3 Infrastructure Improvement Act and requires the ~~[City of North Las Vegas]~~ **Southern Nevada**
4 **Enterprise Community Advisory Board** to develop a ~~[program]~~ project to make certain
5 improvements to infrastructure in and near the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community.

1 WHEREAS, On December 21, 1994, President William Jefferson Clinton
2 designated nine census tracts in the urban core of the Las Vegas Valley as an
3 “enterprise community”; and

4 WHEREAS, The designation was accompanied by an award of \$2,950,000 in
5 Title XX funds to be used for projects in the enterprise community; and

6 WHEREAS, The Southern Nevada Enterprise Community so created includes
7 the target areas of West Las Vegas, East Las Vegas, Meadows Village and North
8 Las Vegas; and

9 WHEREAS, The Southern Nevada Enterprise Community involves a partnership
10 among the cities of Las Vegas and North Las Vegas, and Clark County, working
11 together to harness resources from the public, private and nonprofit sectors to
12 provide programs, services and facilities to the target areas; and

1 WHEREAS, The empowerment of persons and neighborhoods within the
2 Southern Nevada Enterprise Community includes “weed and seed” strategies to
3 “weed” out violence, gangs, drug trafficking and drug-related crime, and to “seed”
4 neighborhoods with social services and economic revitalization; and

5 WHEREAS, Efforts to revitalize neighborhoods economically, to be successful,
6 require a certain minimum level of “infrastructure” in the form of the basic
7 facilities, services and installations needed for the proper functioning of a
8 community; now, therefore

9

10 THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
11 SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

12

13 **Section 1.** ~~[Sections 1 to 15, inclusive, of this]~~ This act may be cited as the
14 ~~North Las Vegas~~ **Southern Nevada Enterprise Community** Infrastructure
15 Improvement Act.

16 **Sec. 2.** As used in sections 1 to ~~15,~~ 13, inclusive, of this act, unless the
17 context otherwise requires, the words and terms defined in sections 3 to 7,
18 inclusive, of this act have the meanings ascribed to them in those sections.

19 **Sec. 3.** ~~["City" means the City of North Las Vegas.]~~ **“Advisory Board”**
20 **means the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community Advisory Board created**
21 **pursuant to section 8 of this act.**

22 **Sec. 4.** ~~["Commission" means the North Las Vegas Infrastructure~~
23 ~~Improvement Commission created pursuant to section 8 of this act.]~~ **(Deleted by**
24 **amendment.)**

25 **Sec. 5.** “Community” means the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community,
26 nine census tracts designated by President William Jefferson Clinton on
27 December 21, 1994.

28 **Sec. 6.** “Infrastructure” means publicly owned or publicly supported facilities
29 that are necessary or desirable to support intense habitation within a region,
30 including, without limitation, parks, roads, schools, libraries, community centers,
31 police and fire protection, sanitary sewers, facilities for mass transit and facilities
32 for the conveyance of water and the treatment of wastewater.

33 **Sec. 7.** ~~["Program"]~~ **“Project”** means the ~~North Las Vegas Infrastructure~~
34 ~~Improvement Program~~ **Southern Nevada Enterprise Community Improvement**
35 **Project** developed pursuant to section ~~10,~~ 11 of this act.

36 **Sec. 8.** 1. The ~~North Las Vegas Infrastructure Improvement Commission~~
37 **Southern Nevada Enterprise Community Advisory Board** is hereby created.

38 2. The ~~Commission~~ **Advisory Board** consists of nine members, appointed
39 in consultation with residents of the Community, as follows:

40 (a) ~~Three members appointed by the Majority Leader of the Senate.~~

41 (b) ~~Three members appointed by the Speaker of the Assembly.~~

42 (c) ~~Three members appointed by the Governor.~~

43 ~~At least seven of the nine members appointed to the Commission must be~~
44 ~~residents of the Community.~~ One member of the Nevada Congressional
45 Delegation selected from among its membership or his designee;

46 (b) The State Senator that represents the Community or his designee;

47 (c) One member of the Clark County Board of County Commissioners
48 selected from among its membership or his designee;

49 (d) One member of the Las Vegas City Council from among its
50 membership or his designee;

51 (e) One member of the North Las Vegas City Council from among its
52 membership or his designee;

1 (f) Two residents of the Community, recommended and selected jointly by
2 the Clark County Board of County Commissioners, the Las Vegas City
3 Council and the North Las Vegas City Council;

4 (g) A representative of the private sector appointed by the Chamber of
5 Commerce established in the Community; and

6 (h) A representative of the nonprofit charitable, educational and religious
7 organizations in the Community, recommended and selected jointly by the
8 Clark County Board of County Commissioners, the Las Vegas City Council
9 and the North Las Vegas City Council.

10 3. Each member of the [Commission] Advisory Board serves for a term of 3
11 years. A vacancy on the [Commission] Advisory Board must be filled in the same
12 manner as the original appointment. A member may be reappointed to the
13 [Commission] Advisory Board.

14 4. The members of the [Commission] Advisory Board shall elect a Chairman
15 and Vice Chairman by majority vote. After the initial election, the Chairman and
16 Vice Chairman shall hold office for a term of 1 year beginning on August 1 of each
17 year. If a vacancy occurs in the chairmanship or vice chairmanship, the members of
18 the [Commission] Advisory Board shall elect a Chairman or Vice Chairman, as
19 appropriate, from among its members for the remainder of the unexpired term.

20 5. [The members of the Commission may, upon written request, receive the
21 per diem allowance and travel expenses provided for state officers and employees
22 generally while engaged in the business of the Commission.]

23 6. A member of the Commission who is an officer or employee of this State
24 or a political subdivision of this State must be relieved from his duties without loss
25 of his regular compensation so that he may prepare for and attend meetings of the
26 Commission and perform any work necessary to carry out the duties of the
27 Commission in the most timely manner practicable. A state agency or political
28 subdivision of this State shall not require an officer or employee who is a member
29 of the Commission to make up the time he is absent from work to carry out his
30 duties as a member of the Commission or use annual vacation or compensatory
31 time for the absence.

32 7. The City of North Las Vegas shall provide administrative support for the
33 [Commission] Advisory Board.

34 Sec. 9. The primary purposes of the [Commission] Advisory Board are to:

35 1. Advise the [governing body of the City] governmental entities that have
36 members on the Advisory Board with respect to the [Program] Project; and

37 2. Ensure that the needs and opinions of the residents of the Community are
38 reflected adequately by the [Program] Project.

39 Sec. 10. [The governing body of the City, in consultation with:

40 1. The Commission;
41 2. The governing body of Clark County;
42 3. Agencies of this State possessing expertise with respect to issues of land
43 use and the development of communities; and

44 4. Agencies of the Federal Government possessing expertise with respect to
45 issues of land use and the development of communities;
46 shall develop or cause to be developed the North Las Vegas Infrastructure
47 Improvement Program.] (Deleted by amendment.)

48 Sec. 11. 1. On or before January 31, 2008, the [governing body of the City
49 shall present to the Commission] Advisory Board shall prepare a written plan to
50 carry out the [Program] Project to address the needs and issues of the
51 Community.
52 2. The [Commission] Advisory Board shall, within 120 days after
53 receiving] preparing the written plan:

1 (a) Hold at least two public hearings on the written plan, each of which must be
2 preceded by at least 30 days' notice ~~is~~ within the Community; and

3 (b) Approve or reject the written plan ~~is~~ based on input from the
4 Community received at the public hearings.

5 3. ~~The Commission shall approve or reject the written plan on the basis of whether the~~ A written plan ~~is~~ adopted by the Advisory Board must:

6 (a) ~~Set~~ Set forth an adequate framework for carrying out the ~~Program~~ Project;

7 (b) ~~Set~~ Set forth a reasonable period in which to accomplish the goals of the ~~Program~~ Project;

8 (c) ~~Incorporate~~ Incorporate each of the required elements of the ~~Program~~ Project, as set forth in section 12 of this act.

9 4. If the ~~Commission~~ Advisory Board rejects the written plan, the ~~Commission~~ Advisory Board shall:

10 (a) Provide to the ~~Governing body of the City~~ appropriate officers of the governmental entities that have members on the Advisory Board a written explanation of its reasons for the rejection; and

11 (b) ~~Request that the governing body of the City submit a revised written plan, and~~

12 ~~(c) Repeat~~ Prepare a revised written plan and repeat the notice and hearings required by subsection 2 before approving or rejecting the revised written plan.

13 Sec. 12. The ~~Program~~ Project must include, without limitation, goals, objectives and policies relating to, and feasible timeframes for achieving:

14 1. The construction, repair and refurbishment of streets, buildings and other facilities as necessary to attract and maintain the viability of successful businesses within the Community;

15 2. ~~The provision of adequate law enforcement, fire protection and emergency medical services, including, without limitation, particular means to ensure that such services are provided in a manner that is responsive to the residents of the Community;~~

16 3. The incorporation within the Community of open space, facilities for recreation, facilities for medical care and other measures as necessary to ensure that the Community develops with mixed uses;

17 4. The eradication of brownfields, the rehabilitation of condemned properties and the removal of structures and facilities that create a disincentive for development; and

18 5. ~~Such other elements as the Commission may, in its discretion, require,~~ Project.

19 Sec. 13. The ~~City~~ Advisory Board may accept any gifts, grants or donations for the purpose of preparing, developing and carrying out the ~~Program~~ Project.

20 Sec. 14. On or before February 1, 2009, the Advisory Board shall submit to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmission to the 75th Session of the Nevada Legislature a report that summarizes the activities of the Advisory Board during the period between the effective date of this act and December 31, 2008.

21 See. 14. Sec. 15. The provisions of NRS 354.599 do not apply to any additional expenses of a local government that are related to the provisions of this act.

22 See. 15. Sec. 16. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
