## SENATE BILL NO. 447—COMMITTEE ON GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS

SUMMARY—Makes various changes to the Charter of Carson City. (BDR S-324)

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AN ACT relating to the Charter of Carson City; **[revising the authority of Carson City to provide water service.]** increasing the number of persons employed in the Office of the Sheriff of Carson City who are exempt from the Merit Personnel System; providing that in a vacancy in the Office of Mayor that the Mayor Pro Tempore shall serve as Mayor until the next general election; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

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## Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law authorizes the Board of Supervisors of Carson City to acquire, improve,  
2 equip, operate and maintain a water project. (Carson City Charter § 2.275) Section 1 of this  
3 bill amends this provision to set forth the specific powers of the Board to provide adequate  
4 and efficient water service to the residents of Carson City.]

5 Existing law requires the Board of Supervisors **of Carson City** to establish a Merit  
6 Personnel System. Currently, five employees in the Office of the Sheriff are exempt from the  
7 System. (Carson City Charter § 2.330) Section 2 of this bill increases that number to six.

8 Existing law provides that the Board of Supervisors shall elect one of its members to  
9 serve as Mayor Pro Tempore. (Carson City Charter § 3.015) Section 3 of this bill provides  
10 that if the Office of Mayor becomes vacant, the Mayor Pro Tempore shall serve as Mayor  
11 until the next general election.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** **[Section 2.275 of the Charter of Carson City, being chapter 92,**  
2 **Statutes of Nevada 1979, at page 147, is hereby amended to read as follows:**

3 **See. 2.275 Power of Board: [Water project.] Provision of adequate**  
4 **and efficient water service.]**

5 **[1.] The Board may [at any time or from time to time acquire,**  
6 **improve, equip, operate and maintain a water project within or without or**  
7 **both within and without Carson City.]**

1               2. As used in subsection 1, "water project" means facilities pertaining  
2 to a municipal water system for the collection, transportation, treatment,  
3 purification and distribution of water, including without limitation springs,  
4 wells, ponds, lakes, other raw water sources, basin cribs, dams, spillways,  
5 retarding basins, detention basins, reservoirs, towers, other storage  
6 facilities, pumping plants, infiltration galleries, filtration plants, purification  
7 systems, other water treatment facilities, power plants, waterwork plants,  
8 pumping stations, gauging stations, ventilating facilities, stream gauges,  
9 rain gauges, valves, stand pipes, connections, hydrants, conduits, flumes,  
10 sluices, canals, channels, ditches, pipes, lines, laterals, service pipes, force  
11 mains, submains, siphons, other water transmission and distribution mains,  
12 engines, boilers, pumps, meters, apparatus, tools, equipment, fixtures,  
13 structures, buildings and other facilities for the acquisition, transportation,  
14 treatment, purification and distribution of untreated water or potable water  
15 for domestic, commercial and industrial use and irrigation (or any  
16 combination thereof), *, for the purpose of providing adequate and*  
17 *efficient water service to the residents of Carson City for all legitimate*  
18 *uses, including, without limitation, industrial, irrigation, municipal and*  
19 *domestic.*

20               1. Acquire, by purchase, grant, gift, devise, lease, construction,  
21 contract or otherwise, land, rights of way, easements, privileges, water  
22 and water rights, and property of every kind, whether real or personal, for  
23 the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating, within or  
24 without Carson City, any and all works and improvements necessary or  
25 proper for the provision of adequate and efficient water service.

26               2. Sell, lease, encumber, hypothecate or otherwise dispose of  
27 property, whether real or personal, including, without limitation, water  
28 and water rights, as is necessary or proper for the provision of adequate  
29 and efficient water service.

30               3. Lawfully enter upon any land, to make surveys and locate any  
31 necessary improvements, including, without limitation, lines for channels,  
32 conduits, canals, pipelines, roadways and other rights of way, to acquire  
33 property necessary or convenient for the construction, use, supply,  
34 maintenance, repair and improvement of such improvements, including,  
35 without limitation, works constructed and being constructed by private  
36 owners, lands for reservoirs for the storage of necessary water, and all  
37 necessary appurtenances, and, where necessary, acquire and hold the  
38 stock of corporations, domestic or foreign, owning water or water rights,  
39 canals, waterworks, franchises, concessions or other rights.

40               4. Enter into and do any acts necessary or proper for the  
41 performance of any agreement with the United States, or any state,  
42 county or district of any kind, public or private corporation, association,  
43 firm or natural person, or any number of them, for the joint acquisition,  
44 construction, lease, ownership, disposition, use, management,  
45 maintenance, repair or operation of any rights, works or other property of  
46 a kind which may be lawfully acquired or owned by Carson City.

47               5. Acquire the right to store water in any reservoirs, or to carry  
48 water through any canal, ditch or conduit not owned or controlled by  
49 Carson City, and grant to any owner or lessee the right to the use of any  
50 water or right to store such water in any reservoir of Carson City, or to  
51 carry such water through any tunnel, canal, ditch or conduit of Carson  
52 City.

1                 6. Enter into and do any acts necessary or proper for the  
2                 performance of any agreement with any district of any kind, public or  
3                 private corporation, association, firm or natural person, or any number of  
4                 them, for the transfer or delivery to any district, corporation, association,  
5                 firm or natural person of any water right or water pumped, stored,  
6                 appropriated or otherwise acquired or secured for the use of Carson City,  
7                 or for the purpose of exchanging the water or water right for any other  
8                 water, water right or water supply to be delivered to Carson City by the  
9                 other party to the agreement.

10                 7. Cooperate and act in conjunction with the State of Nevada or any  
11                 of its engineers, officers, boards, commissions, departments or agencies,  
12                 with the government of the United States or any of its engineers, officers,  
13                 boards, commissions, departments or agencies, or with any public or  
14                 private corporation, to construct any work for the development,  
15                 importation or distribution of water of Carson City, for the protection of  
16                 life or property therein, or for the conservation of its water for beneficial  
17                 use within Carson City, or to carry out any other works, acts or purposes  
18                 provided for in this section, and to adopt and carry out any definite plan  
19                 or system of work for any of the purposes described in this section.

20                 8. Store water in surface or underground reservoirs within or  
21                 without Carson City for the common benefit of Carson City, conserve and  
22                 reclaim water for present and future use within Carson City, appropriate  
23                 and acquire water and water rights and import water into Carson City for  
24                 any useful purpose to Carson City, and commence, maintain, intervene  
25                 and compromise in the name of Carson City, or otherwise, and assume  
26                 the costs and expenses of any action or proceeding involving or affecting:  
27                 (a) The ownership or use of water or water rights within or without  
28                 Carson City used or useful for any purpose of Carson City or of common  
29                 benefit to any land situated therein;

30                 (b) The wasteful use of water within Carson City;

31                 (c) The interference with or diminution of water or water rights  
32                 within Carson City;

33                 (d) The contamination or pollution of the surface or subsurface  
34                 water used in Carson City or any other act that otherwise renders such  
35                 water unfit for beneficial use; and

36                 (e) The interference with this water that may endanger or damage  
37                 the residents, lands or use of water in Carson City.

38                 9. Sell and distribute water under the control of Carson City,  
39                 without preference, to any natural person, firm, corporation, association,  
40                 district, agency or inhabitant, public or private, for use within the service  
41                 area, to fix, establish and adjust rates, classes of rates, terms and  
42                 conditions for the sale and use of such water, and sell water for use  
43                 outside the service area upon a finding by the Board that there is a  
44                 surplus of water above that amount required to serve customers within  
45                 the service area.

46                 10. Supplement the surface water and groundwater resources of  
47                 Carson City by the importation and use of water from other sources.

48                 11. Restrict the use of water of Carson City during any emergency  
49                 caused by drought or other threatened or existing water shortage, and  
50                 prohibit the waste of water of Carson City at any time through the  
51                 adoption of ordinances, rules or regulations and the imposition of fines  
52                 for violations of those ordinances, rules and regulations.

1           **12. Supply water under contract or agreement, or in any other**  
2           **manner, to the United States or any department or agency thereof, the**  
3           **State of Nevada, or any corporation, association, partnership or natural**  
4           **person situated in Carson City, for an appropriate charge, consideration**  
5           **or exchange made therefore, when such supply is available or can be**  
6           **developed as an incident of or in connection with the primary functions**  
7           **and operations of Carson City.] (Deleted by amendment.)**

8           **Sec. 2.** Section 2.330 of the Charter of Carson City, being chapter 690,  
9           Statutes of Nevada 1979, at page 1857, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10          Sec. 2.330 Employees: Merit Personnel System.

11          1. The Board of Supervisors shall establish a Merit Personnel System  
12          for all employees of Carson City except those exempted under the  
13          provisions of subsection 4.

14          2. The Board of Supervisors shall administer this section through the  
15          adoption of appropriate regulations which shall provide for:

16           (a) The classification of all positions, not exempt from the Merit  
17          Personnel System, based on the duties, authority and responsibility of each  
18          position, with adequate provision for reclassification of any position  
19          whatsoever whenever warranted by changed circumstances.

20           (b) A pay plan for all employees, including exempt employees other  
21          than elected officers that are covered in NRS 245.043.

22           (c) Policies and procedures for regulating reduction in force and the  
23          removal of employees.

24           (d) Hours of work, attendance regulations and provisions for sick and  
25          vacation leave.

26           (e) Policies and procedures governing persons holding temporary or  
27          provisional appointments.

28           (f) Policies and procedures governing relationships with employees  
29          and employee organizations.

30           (g) Policies concerning employee training and development.

31           (h) Grievance procedures.

32           (i) Other policies and procedures necessary for the administration of a  
33          Merit Personnel System.

34          3. In the event of a conflict between the policies and procedures  
35          adopted pursuant to this section and the provisions of a collective  
36          bargaining agreement entered into pursuant to chapter 288 of NRS, the  
37          provisions of the agreement prevail.

38          4. There are exempted from the provisions of this section:

39           (a) The Manager and all department heads, elected or appointed;

40           (b) All deputy district attorneys;

41           (c) Not more than ~~five supervisory deputy sheriffs,~~ six employees in  
42          the Office of the Sheriff, as designated by the Sheriff; and

43           (d) ~~Not~~ more than two deputies each in the offices of the Clerk,  
44          the Treasurer, the Recorder, the Assessor, and any other department created  
45          by this Charter or by ordinance.

46           **Sec. 3.** Section 3.015 of the Charter of Carson City, being chapter 690,  
47          Statutes of Nevada 1979, as amended by chapter 58, Statutes of Nevada 1981, at  
48          page 150, is hereby amended to read as follows:

49          Sec. 3.015 Mayor Pro Tempore: Selection; duties. The Board shall  
50          elect one of its members, for such term as the Board determines, to be  
51          Mayor Pro Tempore. He shall:

52           1. Hold the office and title at all times during the term for which he  
53          was elected without additional compensation.

1           2. Perform the duties of Mayor during the absence or disability of the  
2           Mayor.

3           3. *Act as Mayor until the next general election if the Office of*  
4           *Mayor becomes vacant.*

5           **Sec. 4.** Section 3.060 of the Charter of Carson City, being chapter 213,  
6           Statutes of Nevada 1969, as last amended by chapter 341, Statutes of Nevada 1999,  
7           at page 1410, is hereby amended to read as follows:

8           Sec. 3.060 Sheriff: Duties; salary.

9           1. The provisions of chapter 248 of NRS apply to the Office of  
10          Sheriff, except that all deputy sheriffs except ~~the five~~ *any deputy sheriff*  
11          *who is one of the six employees designated by the Sheriff as* described in  
12          section 2.330 must be appointed pursuant to and are governed by the  
13          regulations for the Merit Personnel System.

14           2. The Sheriff shall:

15           (a) Diligently enforce all ordinances of Carson City.

16           (b) Perform such other duties as may be required by:

17           (1) The Board; or

18           (2) The provisions of Nevada Revised Statutes,

19           ↳ which apply to county sheriffs.

20           3. The Sheriff is not answerable upon his official bond for the  
21          conduct of deputies appointed pursuant to the provisions of this Charter, but  
22          the Board may require of such deputies such bonds as it may deem proper.

23           4. The Sheriff is entitled to an annual salary in the amount specified  
24          in NRS 245.043. The Sheriff shall not engage in any other business or  
25          occupation that creates a conflict of interest between his personal interest in  
26          the business or occupation and his official duties.

27           **Sec. 5.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2007.
