AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Office of Veterans’ Services for unanticipated shortfalls in Fiscal Year 2006-2007 for ~~personnel services and~~ utility costs; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the
2 Office of Veterans’ Services the sum of ~~[\$224,196]~~ **\$151,814** for the Veterans’
3 Home Account to cover unanticipated shortfalls in Fiscal Year 2006-2007 for
4 ~~personnel services and~~ utility costs. This appropriation is supplemental to that
5 made by section 22 of chapter 434, Statutes of Nevada 2005, at page 1941.

6 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
