AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Office of Veterans' Services for unanticipated shortfalls in Fiscal Year 2006-2007 for ~~personnel services and~~ utility costs; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Office of Veterans' Services the sum of ~~(\$224,196)~~ **\$151,814** for the Veterans' Home Account to cover unanticipated shortfalls in Fiscal Year 2006-2007 for ~~personnel services and~~ utility costs. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 22 of chapter 434, Statutes of Nevada 2005, at page 1941.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
