

## ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 107—ASSEMBLYMAN OCEGUERA

PREFILED JANUARY 9, 2009

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Referred to Committee on Health and Human Services

**SUMMARY**—Creates the Advisory Committee for the Prevention and Treatment of Stroke and Heart Disease within the Health Division of the Department of Health and Human Services. (BDR 40-208)

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AN ACT relating to public health; creating the Advisory Committee for the Prevention and Treatment of Stroke and Heart Disease within the Health Division of the Department of Health and Human Services; prescribing the duties of the Committee; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1       **Sections 8 and 9** of this bill create the Advisory Committee for the Prevention  
2 and Treatment of Stroke and Heart Disease within the Health Division of the  
3 Department of Health and Human Services and prescribe the duties of the  
4 Committee. **Section 10** of this bill authorizes the Health Division to enter into  
5 contracts and to apply for and accept gifts, grants, donations and bequests to carry  
6 out the provisions of this bill.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** Chapter 439 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 to 10, inclusive, of this  
3 act.  
4       **Sec. 2.** *As used in sections 2 to 10, inclusive, of this act,  
5 unless the context otherwise requires, the words and terms defined  
6 in sections 3 to 7, inclusive, of this act have the meanings ascribed  
7 to them in those sections.*

1       **Sec. 3. "Committee" means the Advisory Committee for the  
2 Prevention and Treatment of Stroke and Heart Disease created by  
3 section 8 of this act.**

4       **Sec. 4. "Hospital" has the meaning ascribed to it in  
5 NRS 449.012.**

6       **Sec. 5. "Primary prevention" means the treatment of risk  
7 factors for stroke, heart disease and other vascular disease in the  
8 general population before the onset of any symptoms.**

9       **Sec. 6. "Provider of health care" has the meaning ascribed  
10 to it in NRS 629.031.**

11       **Sec. 7. "Secondary prevention" means the treatment of  
12 patients who have developed symptoms of stroke, heart disease or  
13 other vascular disease that is designed to prevent the onset of  
14 additional symptoms and attacks of the condition.**

15       **Sec. 8. 1. The Advisory Committee for the Prevention and  
16 Treatment of Stroke and Heart Disease is hereby created within  
17 the Health Division.**

18       **2. The Committee consists of the following members:**

19       **(a) A board-certified neurologist who is licensed to practice in  
20 this State and who is experienced in treating victims of stroke,  
21 appointed by the Administrator;**

22       **(b) A board-certified cardiologist who is licensed to practice in  
23 this State and who is experienced in treating victims of heart  
24 disease and heart attacks, appointed by the Administrator;**

25       **(c) A provider of emergency medical services, appointed by the  
26 Administrator;**

27       **(d) A representative of the Health Division whose primary  
28 responsibilities relate to the licensure and certification of persons  
29 who provide emergency medical services, appointed by the  
30 Administrator;**

31       **(e) A representative of the American Heart Association or its  
32 successor, appointed by the Administrator;**

33       **(f) A person with knowledge or expertise in the prevention of  
34 chronic diseases, appointed by the Administrator;**

35       **(g) A representative from rural Nevada, appointed by the  
36 Administrator;**

37       **(h) A representative of hospitals in this State, appointed by the  
38 Administrator;**

39       **(i) A representative of collectively bargained plans, self-funded  
40 plans or other entities that pay claims under a contract for health  
41 insurance in this State, appointed by the Administrator;**

42       **(j) A registered nurse who is licensed to practice professional  
43 nursing in this State, appointed by the Administrator;**



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1       (k) A person who is a representative of a population  
2 disproportionately affected by heart disease or stroke, appointed by  
3 the Governor;

4       (l) A person who is a survivor of stroke, appointed by the  
5 Majority Leader of the Senate;

6       (m) A person who is a survivor of heart disease, appointed by  
7 the Speaker of the Assembly; and

8       (n) A representative of the Nevada System of Higher  
9 Education who has knowledge of matters relating to public health,  
10 appointed by the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada.

11      3. The Committee shall elect a Chairman and a Vice  
12 Chairman from among its members to initial terms expiring on  
13 June 30, 2011. After the initial election, each of those officers  
14 holds office for a term of 1 year beginning on July 1 of each year  
15 and may be reelected to one or more successive terms. If a vacancy  
16 occurs in the chairmanship or vice chairmanship, the members of  
17 the Committee shall elect a replacement for the remainder of the  
18 unexpired term.

19      4. After the initial terms, each member of the Committee  
20 serves a term of 2 years beginning on July 1. Except for a member  
21 appointed pursuant to paragraph (f) of subsection 2, a member  
22 may be reappointed to one or more successive terms.

23      5. A vacancy on the Committee must be filled for the  
24 remainder of the unexpired term in the same manner as the  
25 original appointment.

26      6. The members of the Committee serve without  
27 compensation. If sufficient money is available, each member is  
28 entitled to receive the per diem allowance and travel expenses  
29 provided for state officers and employees generally while attending  
30 meetings of the Committee or otherwise engaged in the business of  
31 the Committee.

32      Sec. 9. 1. The Committee shall, to the extent money is  
33 available from any source:

34       (a) Adopt rules for its own governance.

35       (b) Meet at least once each calendar quarter and at other times  
36 upon the call of the Chairman.

37       (c) Make recommendations to the Health Division for the  
38 establishment of a comprehensive plan for the prevention of  
39 stroke, heart disease and other vascular disease in this State which  
40 must:

41           (1) Emphasize the development of a policy for the primary  
42 prevention and secondary prevention of stroke;

43           (2) Include recommendations to eliminate disparities in  
44 vascular health among populations that are disproportionately  
45 affected by stroke, heart disease and other vascular disease;



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1           (3) *Include recommendations concerning methods of  
2 increasing public knowledge and awareness relating to vascular  
3 health, including, without limitation, the prevention and treatment  
4 of stroke, heart disease and other vascular disease;*

5           (4) *Include recommendations concerning acute stroke  
6 treatment, including treatment during the hyperacute and  
7 emergency phases of stroke;*

8           (5) *Include recommendations concerning the rehabilitation  
9 of patients and continuous quality improvement activities for  
10 medical facilities and providers of health care; and*

11          (6) *Include recommendations concerning the notification  
12 and response of emergency medical services.*

13          (d) *On or before May 1 of each year, submit a written report to  
14 the Health Division summarizing the activities of the Committee  
15 and any recommendations it has made.*

16          (e) *In carrying out its duties, solicit suggestions and  
17 information from:*

18           (1) *Providers of emergency medical services;*

19           (2) *Associations of medical professionals;*

20           (3) *Hospitals;*

21           (4) *The Health Division;*

22          (5) *The Board of Medical Examiners and other boards  
23 responsible for issuing a license to a provider of health care; and*

24          (6) *Other persons with interests relating to vascular health  
25 as deemed necessary by the Committee.*

26          2. *In making the recommendations required by paragraph (c)  
27 of subsection 1, the Committee shall not consider or address any  
28 issue concerning the transfer of a patient.*

29          3. *A majority of the members of the Committee constitutes a  
30 quorum for the transaction of business, and a majority of a  
31 quorum present at any meeting is sufficient for any official action  
32 taken by the Committee.*

33          Sec. 10. 1. *The Health Division may:*

34           (a) *Enter into contracts for any service necessary to carry out  
35 the provisions of sections 2 to 10, inclusive, of this act; and*

36           (b) *Apply for and accept gifts, grants, donations and bequests  
37 from any source to carry out the provisions of sections 2 to 10,  
38 inclusive, of this act.*

39          2. *Any money collected pursuant to subsection 1 and any  
40 money appropriated to carry out the provisions of sections 2 to 10,  
41 inclusive, of this act:*

42           (a) *Must be deposited in the State Treasury and accounted for  
43 separately in the State General Fund; and*



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1       (b) Except as otherwise provided by the terms of a specific gift,  
2 grant, donation or bequest, must only be expended to carry out the  
3 provisions of sections 2 to 10, inclusive, of this act.

4       3. The Administrator shall administer the account. Any  
5 interest or income earned on the money in the account must be  
6 credited to the account.

7       4. Any claims against the account must be paid as other  
8 claims against the State are paid.

9       **Sec. 11.** On or before July 1, 2010:

10      1. The Administrator of the Health Division of the Department  
11 of Health and Human Services shall appoint the following members  
12 to the Advisory Committee for the Prevention and Treatment of  
13 Stroke and Heart Disease created by section 8 of this act:

14      (a) One member each pursuant to paragraphs (a) to (f),  
15 inclusive, of subsection 2 of section 8 of this act to initial terms  
16 commencing on July 1, 2010, and expiring on June 30, 2011.

17      (b) One member each pursuant to paragraphs (g) to (j),  
18 inclusive, of subsection 2 of section 8 of this act to initial terms  
19 commencing on July 1, 2010, and expiring on June 30, 2012.

20      2. The Governor shall appoint to the Committee one member  
21 pursuant to paragraph (k) of subsection 2 of section 8 of this act to  
22 an initial term commencing on July 1, 2010, and expiring on  
23 June 30, 2012.

24      3. The Majority Leader of the Senate shall appoint to the  
25 Committee one member pursuant to paragraph (l) of subsection 2 of  
26 section 8 of this act to an initial term commencing on July 1, 2010,  
27 and expiring on June 30, 2012.

28      4. The Speaker of the Assembly shall appoint one member to  
29 the Committee pursuant to paragraph (m) of subsection 2 of section  
30 8 of this act to an initial term commencing on July 1, 2010, and  
31 expiring on June 30, 2012.

32      5. The Board of Regents of the University of Nevada shall  
33 appoint one member to the Committee pursuant to paragraph (n) of  
34 subsection 2 of section 8 of this act to an initial term commencing  
35 on July 1, 2010, and expiring on June 30, 2012.

36       **Sec. 12.** 1. This section and section 11 of this act become  
37 effective on October 1, 2009.

38       2. Sections 1 to 10, inclusive, of this act become effective on  
39 July 1, 2010.
