

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 155—ASSEMBLYMEN MUNFORD, DENIS,  
SEGERBLOM; BOBZIEN, OHRENSCHALL AND PIERCE

FEBRUARY 11, 2009

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Referred to Committee on Education

SUMMARY—Enacts provisions related to multicultural education.  
(BDR 34-142)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: No.

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

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AN ACT relating to education; requiring the State Board of Education to adopt a program of multicultural education for certain pupils; requiring certain licensed teachers to complete a course in multicultural education upon renewal of their license; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1      **Section 1** of this bill requires the State Board of Education to adopt a program  
2 of multicultural education. **Section 1** also requires the boards of trustees of school  
3 districts to ensure that the program is provided to pupils enrolled in grades 2  
4 through 12.

5      **Section 2** of this bill requires a licensed teacher who submits an application on  
6 or after January 1, 2011, to submit proof of his completion of a course in  
7 multicultural education unless the teacher has previously completed such a course.  
8 **Section 2** also requires the Commission on Professional Standards in Education to  
9 prescribe the contents and credits required for a course in multicultural education.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** Chapter 389 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3      ***1. The State Board shall adopt regulations that prescribe a  
4 program of multicultural education, including, without limitation,  
5 information relating to the contributions made by men and women  
6 from various racial and ethnic backgrounds.***

1       **2. The board of trustees of each school district shall ensure  
2 that the program prescribed pursuant to subsection 1 is provided  
3 to pupils enrolled in grades 2 to 12, inclusive, with particular  
4 emphasis for pupils enrolled in elementary school, middle school  
5 and junior high school.**

6       **Sec. 2.** Chapter 391 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
7 thereto a new section to read as follows:

8       **1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, a licensed  
9 teacher who submits an application for renewal of his license to  
10 teach on or after January 1, 2011, shall submit with his  
11 application proof of the completion of a course in multicultural  
12 education.**

13       **2. A licensed teacher is not required to submit proof of the  
14 completion of a course pursuant to subsection 1 if the teacher has  
15 previously completed such a course and filed proof of the  
16 completion with the Superintendent of Public Instruction.**

17       **3. The Commission shall adopt regulations:**

18       **(a) That prescribe the required contents of a course in  
19 multicultural education which must be completed pursuant to this  
20 section;**

21       **(b) That prescribe the number of credits which must be earned  
22 by the licensed teacher in a course of multicultural education; and**

23       **(c) As otherwise necessary to carry out the requirements of this  
24 section.**

25       **Sec. 3.** 1. On or before January 1, 2010, the Commission on  
26 Professional Standards in Education shall adopt regulations to carry  
27 out the provisions of section 2 of this act.

28       2. On or before March 1, 2010, the Commission on  
29 Professional Standards in Education shall provide a report to the  
30 Legislative Committee on Education on the status of the regulations  
31 adopted pursuant to section 2 of this act, including, without  
32 limitation, an estimate of the number of teachers who will be  
33 required to renew a license during 2011 with the proof of the  
34 completion of a course in multicultural education required by  
35 section 2 of this act.

36       **Sec. 4.** The State Board of Education shall:

37       1. On or before March 1, 2010, provide a report to the  
38 Legislative Committee on Education on the status of the regulations  
39 prescribing a program of multicultural education required by section  
40 1 of this act, including, without limitation, the implementation of the  
41 regulations by the boards of trustees of school districts.

42       2. On or before February 1, 2011, provide a report to the  
43 Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmission to  
44 the 76th Session of the Nevada Legislature concerning the  
45 implementation of the program of multicultural education prescribed

1 pursuant to section 1 of this act in the public schools and a  
2 preliminary report on the effectiveness of the program.

3       **Sec. 5.** The provisions of section 2 of this act apply to each  
4 licensed teacher in this State, regardless of the date on which his  
5 initial license was issued.

6       **Sec. 6.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2009.
