

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 2—ASSEMBLYMAN CARPENTER

PREFILED NOVEMBER 20, 2008

Referred to Committee on Judiciary

SUMMARY—Requires each officer of the Nevada Highway Patrol to complete certain training in the proper installation of a child restraint system. (BDR 43-2)

AN ACT relating to public safety; requiring each officer of the Nevada Highway Patrol to complete certain training in the proper installation of a child restraint system; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law requires a person transporting a child who is less than 6 years of
2 age and who weighs 60 pounds or less in a motor vehicle to secure the child in a
3 child restraint system. Existing law also provides for a person or agency approved
4 by the Department of Public Safety to conduct programs of training and perform
5 inspections of child restraint systems. (NRS 484.474) Existing law requires the
6 personnel of the Nevada Highway Patrol to aid in enforcing the provisions of
7 chapter 484 of NRS, among others. (NRS 480.360) This bill requires each officer
8 of the Nevada Highway Patrol to complete training in the installation and proper
9 use of a child restraint system.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 480 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 ***1. Each officer of the Nevada Highway Patrol shall complete***
4 ***training in the proper installation of a child restraint system. The***
5 ***training may be completed in a program authorized by the***
6 ***Department pursuant to NRS 484.474, or in a separate program***
7 ***conducted by the Department for officers of the Nevada Highway***
8 ***Patrol.***



- 1 2. *As used in this section, “child restraint system” has the*
2 *meaning ascribed to it in NRS 484.474.*
