SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing the confidentiality of a report of trichomonosis in cattle. (BDR 50-1005)

AN ACT relating to diseased animals; providing that a report of trichomonosis in cattle submitted to the State Quarantine Officer is not confidential under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 Existing law requires owners or agents in charge of infected animals, inspectors  
2 of the State Department of Agriculture and practicing veterinarians to notify the  
3 State Quarantine Officer immediately if any of those persons has knowledge of any  
4 animal infected with any infectious, contagious or parasitic disease, but requires the  
5 notification of disease to be kept confidential except in certain circumstances. (NRS  
6 571.160) This bill expands the exceptions to the confidentiality requirement to  
7 include instances in which the reported disease is trichomonosis in cattle.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** NRS 571.160 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2      571.160 If any animal becomes infected with any infectious,  
3 contagious or parasitic disease as defined by rules and regulations  
4 adopted by the State Quarantine Officer, the owner or agent in  
5 charge of the infected animal, or any inspector of the Department or  
6 any practicing veterinarian who has knowledge of the infected  
7 animal, shall immediately notify the State Quarantine Officer.  
8 Except as otherwise provided in NRS 239.0115, a notification of

1 disease received pursuant to this section must be kept confidential  
2 unless:

3       1. The reported disease is **[specifically]**:

4       (a) **Specifically** regulated pursuant to NRS 571.130 for  
5 mandatory control and eradication to protect the public health, other  
6 animals or wildlife; or

7       (b) **Trichomonosis in cattle; or**

8       2. The State Quarantine Officer determines that a public health  
9 emergency exists.

10     **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
