AN ACT relating to dentistry; authorizing the Board of Dental Examiners of Nevada to issue limited permits to treat patients under certain circumstances as part of a supervised course of dental education; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 **Section 1** of this bill allows a person licensed to practice dentistry in another
2 jurisdiction to receive a limited permit to treat a specified patient as part of a
3 supervised course of dental education under certain circumstances. **Section 1** also
4 places certain restrictions on the treatment of a patient by a person who receives
5 such a limited permit. A limited permit issued under **section 1** expires 5 years after
6 being issued and may be renewed for an additional year if necessary to complete
7 the course of continuing dental education.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 631 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *1. The Board shall, without a clinical examination required
4 by NRS 631.240 or 631.300, issue a limited permit to a person to
5 treat a specified patient if the person:*

6 *(a) Is a student enrolled in a supervised course of dental
7 education presented as part of a program of postgraduate dental
8 education; and*

9 *(b) Has a license to practice dentistry issued pursuant to the
10 laws of another state or territory of the United States, the District
11 of Columbia or a foreign country that authorizes the person to
12 treat the specified patient in that jurisdiction.*

13 *2. A person to whom a limited permit is issued pursuant to
14 this section may only treat a specified patient who:*

15 *(a) Is a patient of the person in the jurisdiction in which the
16 person is licensed to practice dentistry; and*

17 *(b) Has provided a properly executed informed consent to the
18 treatment.*

19 *3. A limited license issued pursuant to this section authorizes
20 the person to whom it is issued to practice only at the facility at
21 which the supervised course of dental education is conducted
22 while under the direct supervision of a member of the faculty at
23 that facility.*

24 *4. A limited permit expires 5 years after the date of its
25 issuance and may be renewed on or before the date of its
26 expiration for 1 additional year if necessary for the completion of
27 a supervised course of dental education.*
