SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Nevada Rural Counties RSVP Program, Inc. (BDR S-275)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Nevada Rural Counties RSVP Program, Inc., for programs that support senior citizens; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the disbursement account created by section 1 of
3 chapter 345, Statutes of Nevada 2007, at page 1599, for the use
4 of the Nevada Rural Counties RSVP Program, Inc., the sum of
5 \$1,000,000.

6 2. The Nevada Rural Counties RSVP Program, Inc., shall use
7 the money appropriated by subsection 1 for the support of its
8 independent living programs for senior citizens.

9 3. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,
10 the Nevada Rural Counties RSVP Program, Inc., shall:

11 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
12 Committee on or before December 15, 2010, that describes each
13 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
14 from the date on which the money was received by the Program
15 through December 1, 2010;



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1 (b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance
2 Committee on or before September 16, 2011, that describes each
3 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
4 from the date on which the money was received by the Program
5 through June 30, 2011; and

6 (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
7 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,
8 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or
9 otherwise, of the Program, regardless of their form or location, that
10 the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct an audit of the
11 use of the money appropriated by subsection 1.

12 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
13 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
14 June 30, 2011, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or
15 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
16 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
17 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
18 after September 16, 2011, by either the entity to which the money
19 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
20 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
21 Fund on or before September 16, 2011.

22 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2009.

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
