**SUMMARY**—Requires the Director of the State Department of Agriculture to appoint a person as a resource management specialist in the Department. (BDR 50-1027)

**AN ACT** relating to agriculture; requiring the Director of the State Department of Agriculture to appoint a person as a resource management specialist in the Department; setting forth the duties of the person appointed; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Existing law requires the Director of the State Department of Agriculture to appoint persons to manage the various activities of the Department, including activities relating to the livestock industry, the agricultural industry and natural resources in Nevada. (NRS 561.205, 561.214, 561.218) This bill requires the Director to appoint a person as a resource management specialist in the Department. The person appointed is in the unclassified service of the State and must be appointed on the basis of merit and have at least a master's degree in agriculture or a related field specified by the Director. The duties of the person appointed consist of managing all policy and regulatory matters of the Department which affect the production of agriculture in Nevada and performing any other duties assigned to him by the Director concerning the management of agricultural resources in Nevada. This bill authorizes not more than one-half of the salary and other expenses of the person appointed to be paid each year from private sources.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** Chapter 561 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3      *1. The Director shall appoint a person as a resource  
4 management specialist in the Department. The person is in the  
5 unclassified service of the State and must:*

6      *(a) Be appointed on the basis of merit; and*

7      *(b) Have at least a master's degree in agriculture or a related  
8 field specified by the Director.*

9      *2. The Director may remove the person from office with the  
10 approval of the Board.*

11     *3. A person appointed as a resource management specialist  
12 pursuant to subsection 1 shall:*

13     *(a) Manage all policy and regulatory matters of the  
14 Department which affect the production of agriculture in this  
15 State, including, without limitation, the use of water for  
16 agricultural purposes in this State; and*

17     *(b) Perform any other duties assigned to him by the Director  
18 concerning the management of agricultural resources in this  
19 State, including, without limitation, soil, vegetation and range  
20 conditions.*

21     *4. Each year, not more than one-half of the salary and other  
22 costs and expenses of the person appointed as a resource  
23 management specialist pursuant to subsection 1 may be paid from  
24 private sources.*

25      **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2009.
