
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 373—ASSEMBLYWOMAN MCCLAIN

MARCH 16, 2009

Referred to Committee on Ways and Means

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation for the State's share of the cost of establishing a veterans' home in northern Nevada. (BDR S-999)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Office of Veterans' Services for the State's share of the cost of establishing a veterans' home in northern Nevada; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Office of Veterans' Services for the State's
3 share of the cost of establishing a veterans' home in northern
4 Nevada the sum of \$25,000,000, the State's 35 percent share of the
5 total estimated cost of \$62,000,000.

6 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,
7 the Office of Veterans' Services shall:

8 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance
9 Committee on or before December 15, 2010, that describes each
10 expenditure made from the money appropriated in subsection 1 from
11 the date on which the money was received by the Office of
12 Veterans' Services through December 1, 2010;

13 (b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance
14 Committee on or before September 16, 2011, that describes each
15 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1
16 from the date on which the money was received by the Office of
17 Veterans' Services through June 30, 2011; and



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1 (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available
2 to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims,
3 reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or
4 otherwise, of the Office of Veterans' Services, regardless of their
5 form or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to
6 conduct an audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to
7 subsection 1.

8 **Sec. 2.** The sums appropriated by section 1 of this act are
9 available for either fiscal year. Any remaining balance of those sums
10 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2011, by the
11 entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which
12 money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in
13 any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining
14 must not be spent for any purpose after September 16, 2011,
15 by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the
16 entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred,
17 and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before
18 September 16, 2011.

19 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2009.

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
