SUMMARY—Increases the fee for reinstatement of a driver's license or commercial driver's license. (BDR 43-515)

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; increasing the fee for the reinstatement of a driver's license or commercial driver's license that has been suspended, revoked, cancelled or disqualified under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 A person whose driver's license or commercial driver's license has been
2 suspended or revoked for a violation relating to driving under the influence of
3 alcohol or a controlled substance, or has been suspended, revoked, cancelled or
4 disqualified for other reasons, must pay a fee to reinstate his license. (NRS 483.410,
5 483.910) This bill increases the amount of the fee.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 483.410 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 483.410 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 6 and
3 NRS 483.417, for every driver's license, including a motorcycle
4 driver's license, issued and service performed, the following fees
5 must be charged:

19 2. For every motorcycle endorsement to a driver's license, a
20 fee of \$5 must be charged.

21 3. If no other change is requested or required, the Department
22 shall not charge a fee to convert the number of a license from the
23 licensee's social security number, or a number that was formulated
24 by using the licensee's social security number as a basis for the
25 number, to a unique number that is not based on the licensee's social
26 security number.

27 4. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 483.417, the increase
28 in fees authorized by NRS 483.347 and the fees charged pursuant to
29 NRS 483.415 must be paid in addition to the fees charged pursuant
30 to subsections 1 and 2.

31 5. A penalty of \$10 must be paid by each person renewing his
32 license after it has expired for a period of 30 days or more as
33 provided in NRS 483.386 unless he is exempt pursuant to that
34 section.

35 6. The Department may not charge a fee for the reinstatement
36 of a driver's license that has been:

37 (a) Voluntarily surrendered for medical reasons; or

38 (b) Cancelled pursuant to NRS 483.310.

39 7. All fees and penalties are payable to the Administrator at the
40 time a license or a renewal license is issued.

41 8. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 483.340, subsection 3
42 of NRS 483.3485, NRS 483.415 and 483.840, and subsection 3 of
43 NRS 483.863, all money collected by the Department pursuant to
44 this chapter must be deposited in the State Treasury for credit to the
45 Motor Vehicle Fund.

1 2. The Department shall charge and collect an annual fee of
2 \$555 from each person who is authorized by the Department to
3 administer a driving skills test pursuant to NRS 483.912.

4 3. An additional charge of \$3 must be charged for each
5 knowledge test administered to a person who has twice failed the
6 test.

7 4. An additional charge of \$25 must be charged for each
8 driving skills test administered to a person who has twice failed the
9 test.

10 5. The increase in fees authorized in NRS 483.347 must be
11 paid in addition to the fees charged pursuant to this section.

12 6. The Department shall charge an applicant for a hazardous
13 materials endorsement an additional fee for the processing of
14 fingerprints. The Department shall establish the additional fee by
15 regulation, except that the amount of the additional fee must not
16 exceed the sum of the amount charged by the Central Repository for
17 Nevada Records of Criminal History and each applicable federal
18 agency to process the fingerprints for a background check of the
19 applicant in accordance with Section 1012 of the Uniting and
20 Strengthening America by Providing Appropriate Tools Required to
21 Intercept and Obstruct Terrorism Act (USA PATRIOT ACT) of
22 2001, 49 U.S.C. § 5103a.

23 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2009.
