SUMMARY—Makes a supplemental appropriation to the Office for Consumer Health Assistance in the Office of the Governor for unanticipated shortfalls in Fiscal Year 2008-2009 for the Bureau for Hospital Patients. (BDR S-1249)

AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Office for Consumer Health Assistance in the Office of the Governor for unanticipated shortfalls in Fiscal Year 2008-2009 for the Bureau for Hospital Patients; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the Office for Consumer Health Assistance in the
3 Office of the Governor the sum of \$181,169 for the Bureau for
4 Hospital Patients to address the incorrect reversion of prior fiscal
5 year annual assessments paid by certain hospitals. This
6 appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 2 of chapter
7 350, Statutes of Nevada 2007, at page 1694.

8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
