

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 553—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

MAY 5, 2009

Referred to Committee on Ways and Means

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation for the coordination of services in Nevada Schools. (BDR S-1285)

AN ACT making an appropriation for the coordination of student and family services in Nevada schools; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to Communities in Schools of Southern Nevada, Inc., the sum of \$1,000,000 to coordinate the provision of student and family services to youth in all Nevada schools.

2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1, Communities in Schools of Southern Nevada, Inc., shall:

(a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance Committee on or before December 15, 2010, that describes each expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1 from the date on which the money was received by Communities in Schools of Southern Nevada, Inc., through December 1, 2010;

(b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance Committee on or before September 16, 2011, that describes each expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1 from the date on which the money was received by Communities in Schools of Southern Nevada, Inc., through June 30, 2011; and

(c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available to the Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims, reports, vouchers or other records of information, confidential or



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1 otherwise, of Communities in Schools of Southern Nevada, Inc.,
2 regardless of their form or location, that the Legislative Auditor
3 deems necessary to conduct an audit of the use of the money
4 appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.

5 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
6 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
7 June 30, 2011, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or
8 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
9 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
10 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
11 after September 16, 2011, by either the entity to which the money
12 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
13 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
14 Fund on or before September 16, 2011.

15 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2009.
